Thank you for praying for us this last month. We are officially on furlough.

We made it to Texas on Friday August 4th. On Saturday I went out soulwinning with the Open Door Baptist Church in Weslaco, TX. They had a men's meeting that night and I was able to preach. The next morning, we presented our ministry at the church and they took us on for support.

Then it was on to Bible Baptist Church in Shreveport, LA to report on the work on August 9th. On August 13th we were at the King's Way Baptist Church in Douglasville,

GA. We reported on the work and then I preached in their Spanish Department. The Lord worked in hearts there. Then we headed north and made it to Glen Burnie, MD. I was in Glen Burnie until the 31st when I flew to California to report to our supporting churches out west. The Central Baptist Church of Orange County rented me a car for the first week I was here and then a family in the church lent me a car. The vehicle has been a great blessing.

Since getting in the states, we have gone soulwinning several times and I have witnessed to 9 people with 6 of them accepting Christ. I have had the privilege of preaching in 13 different churches and two Christian schools. Thank you for praying for us.

I will fly back to Maryland on October 10th. I will spend a few days "home" in Glen Burnie before leaving for the Northeast where I will be visiting churches in New York, Connecticut, Rhode Island, Massachusetts and Maine.

Lord willing, I will line up several more meetings for this fall in the east and then will be going south for the winter.

We are thankful for our 2014 Chevrolet Traverse. It now has over 157,000 miles on it and has a life expectancy of about 200,000 miles. So, while are on furlough we will be awful close to needing another vehicle. Before we go home (Mexico is home for us) after furlough, we hope to get another vehicle. Please pray with us that the Lord will meet this need.

It has been a blessing to see the church families that have supported us for many years. I have been spoiled, honored and refreshed. I am looking forward to trying to visit all of our supporting churches while we are on furlough.

Thank you for your faithfulness to pray for us. We appreciate everything that you do for us. What an honor it is to be able to represent you as missionaries.
