Dear Friends and church family,

Thank you for praying for us during the month of January. Every year during January, vehicle and property taxes come due. Yes, we pay taxes in Mexico. No, it's not nearly as much as in the US. But that's the reason the roads in Mexico are so bad.

We also pay vehicle insurance every January. Yes, we keep Mexican insurance on vehicles in Mexico. For the entire 12 months of 2024 on my 1992 brown Van, I paid \$250. I feel sorry for you all in the US. But I think I have been hit 4 times in the 3 years we have been living here in Mexico. Big trucks and buses are usually the culprits. Oh my, It's fun to drive in Mexico. Just last week, while moving along about 50 mph, the lug nuts of the front wheel of a giant rig dug into our front passenger door right where Carrie was sitting. Their insurance paid for it, but it sort of rattled Carrie, to say the least. Praise the Lord we are both fine.

Due to the amazing generosity of some very wonderful people in the US, we were able to donate an electronic piano keyboard to the mountain church in La Chona. We also gave them a pulpit donated by a church in Cleburne, Texas., and 30 hymnals that we print here in Mexico with the financial help of some very wonderful prayer warriors back home. 80 songs with words and guitar chords. The fingering for every guitar chord is printed in the back of the hymnal so that anyone who wants too can provide the music for their church.

We had **4 saved out soulwinning** on our bus route in Zapata this month. And Thanks for praying for Daniel. He has been coming faithfully.

We took **99 BEAMS Bibles** to A "Fires of Evangelism" conference in Villahermosa, Tabasco with 18 pastors and many church members. It was our first time there, but we made many new friends with great soulwinning men of God.

We visited Palenque, Chiapas Mexico with Pastor Jeronimo Guzman and his wife, Mayda. They have a new baby, Andrea. It was their 6<sup>th</sup> year church anniversary. 43 present Sunday morning, 36 Sunday night, and 27 on Wednesday night. There were **4 saved Sunday morning**. After the service, **Carrie led a wife to the Lord**, whose husband accepted Jesus during the invitation. We went soulwinning Wednesday, and **2 more were saved in the home**.

The day we left Palenque, we first went to a livestock supply store and bought a large cattle watering tank. Why? It is now their baptistry! They have been baptizing in a river! You would be proud of the way they are serving the Lord in Palenque. Pray for wisdom and finances as they have building needs for the church and are in need of a van for the church.

It got cold in Monterrey during January. Both of our bougainvillea bushes lost all their leaves and flowers. All the other tropical plants we have are brown, as well. I pray they survive. A couple years ago we got a real hard freeze for several days which killed several of our trees. Please pray for the hearts of the people to not be cold to the Gospel as we witness for Jesus. Amen.

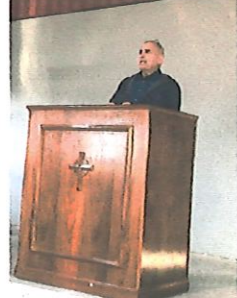
