

LIBERTY RADIO

Seventeen years ago, while Liberia was still reeling from a fourteen-year civil war, Dr. George Zarris, Director of Christian Radio International (CRI), visited the capital city of Monrovia. The dictator president had recently been removed, free elections were planned, and twenty-three candidates were fighting for control of the government. It was a recipe for a bloodbath.

In the midst of this seething cauldron, CRI partnered with National Pastor Dahn Demey and Dr. Edgar Feghaly to build *Liberty Radio*, which became the only radio station broadcasting at the time except for the UN channel. God knew we would have a "captive audience." It was estimated that *Liberty Radio* grew to 500,000 listeners per day in a country of four million people. Even the newly elected President of Liberia became a regular listener, and she often proclaimed over the air, "What Liberia needs is more radio stations like *Liberty Radio*."

The stories of conversions are legendary. Who would have believed that a rebel leader (trained in Libya) would foment sedition, commit heinous crimes, annihilate entire villages, and years later, call *Liberty Radio* in mental anguish and overwhelming guilt. "Is there any hope for me?" he queried. He accepted Christ as his Savior, graduated from Bible college in 2022 at the age of sixty, and is a pastor today.

Similarly, Muslims were shocked when a sheik (a religious leader specifically trained to defend the Koran) began listening to a program comparing Islam to Christianity. The sheik called the station many times to passionately refute biblical doctrines on the air, but the more he read the Bible, the more his Muslim beliefs eroded. Two months later, he called the station and prayed to accept Christ. Immediately, he lost his job, his house, and his wife's business. Nevertheless, he enrolled in the Bible college and is now in his third year. (By the way, he is blind!)

The stories are endless. Area churches are full of members whose lives were changed by the message of forgiveness and restoration that *Liberty Radio* proclaims. Dozens of listeners, both men and women, have attended

Blessed Hope Bible College (15 are presently enrolled) and have been trained to serve. However...

The radio station equipment that was state-of-the-art in 2006 is now archaic. (Think of a seventeen-year-old computer running 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.) Repairs are no longer cost effective. 
ARGENTINA Catamarca

IRAN Turning Mosques Into Churches Testimony from Iran Alive Ministries


