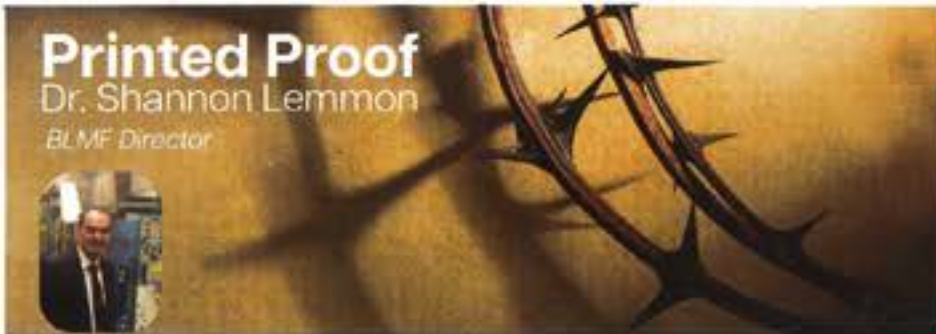

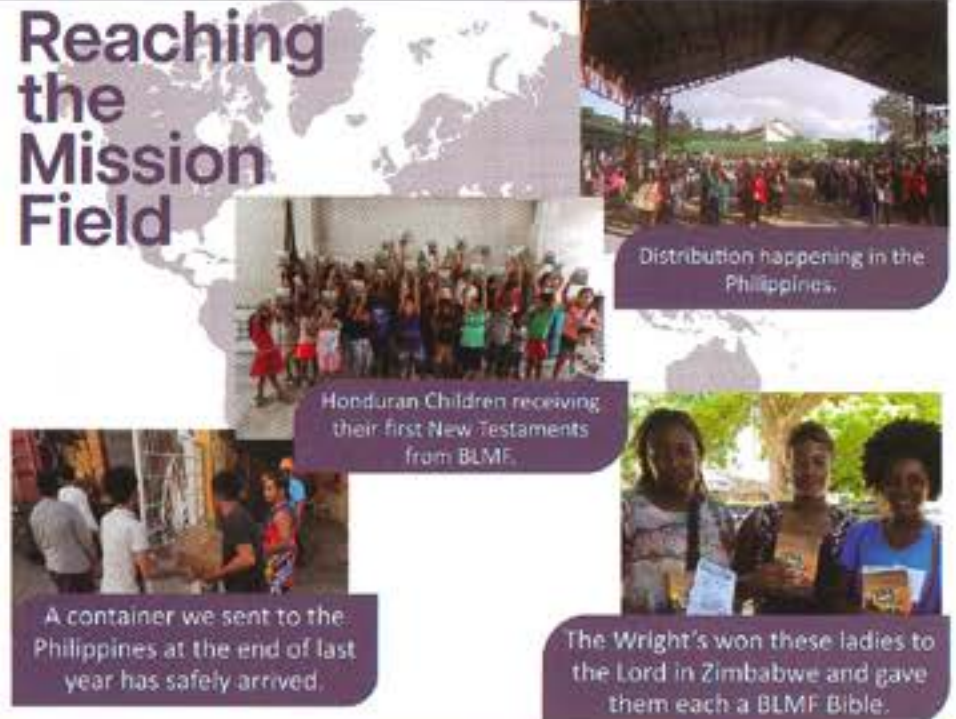


The absolute power and necessity of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ shapes Christianity itself. Without the bodily Resurrection of Christ, the Gospel would be incomplete. Of course, many desire proof of such a miraculous "claim." Online search engines will inform you there is no evidence of a bodily resurrection from the grave of Jesus. Since the beginning of time, folks have wanted a witness to believe pretty much anything. Was Jesus the Son of God, and did He really arise? We first see a man prepared by the Lord to be such a witness: John the Baptist. "The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all men through him might believe" (John 1:7). Just hear John boldly shouting, "There He is! The Lamb that taketh away the sins of the world!" What a wonderful proclamation shouted from the baptismal waters just before the Holy Spirit lighted upon our Saviour! It is the Holy Spirit who also serves as a witness to His divinity and to His Resurrection. "But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you" (Romans 8:11). Turn your thoughts or words to the cross and the resurrected Christ, my friend, and soon the Holy Spirit within your soul will be making you rejoice! It is the job of the Holy Spirit to magnify Jesus Christ, and we know Christ is alive as His Spirit works in our lives! If it is a multitude of witnesses that tickles one's fancy, they served as a witness as well. "And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures: And that he was seen of Cephas, then of the twelve: After that he was seen of above five hundred brethren at once; of whom the greater part remain unto this present..." (1 Corinthians 15:4-6a). More than five hundred witnessed the Resurrected Christ. Yet, the eternity-changing truth is that the Scriptures themselves serve as a witness. The Word of God serves as a testimony itself to the Resurrected Word of Life! "For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; And

that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:"(1 Corinthians 15:3,4). This very written Word of Life must be produced for a world in need of Truth!

So encouraging to this ministry are the stories shared from the foreign mission fields where these Scriptures are shipped and distributed. One such story comes from a small village in the jungles of the Philippines. Guerilla warfare was rampant in the 1970's, and an attack occurred in this small village as the guerillas arrived. A dear young woman was attempting to run for her life when a large machine gun was put to her head. In a moment of desperation, the lady cried out the only prayer she had ever known to pray, "Save me, Oh God, who sent your Son to die!" The gun jammed, and the man immediately ran away leaving her unharmed. It was within the next decade that a precious missionary family arrived. They were able to share the Gospel with this lady, and she finally – for the first time – learned the precious name of the very Son that the God of her prayers had sent. "Jesus! Jesus! Jesus!" She couldn't help but continually cry out the name of her Saviour, who had just saved her soul! Every time, the written Word of God testifies the Truth of the Resurrected Christ to those seeking hope, love, and salvation. This GLOBAL WITNESS – the Pure, Preserved Word of God – must be printed! John the Baptist and the five hundred are no longer here, but the Holy Spirit still works through His Holy Word in miraculous ways! "He lives! He lives! Salvation to impart! You ask me how I know He lives...He lives within my heart!" What will you do this Resurrection Day to get the Truth of our Saviour to a lost world in need? Could you, your family, or your Church sponsor paper in honor of the Resurrection power? We will never regret producing and sending this printed proof, the Bible! Let us hold forth the Word of Life so all may receive a new life in the Risen Christ! "Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ, that I have not run in vain, neither labored in vain" (Philippians 2:16).

Please let me take this opportunity to extend my personal appreciation and thanks to all of you wonderful pastors, churches and Christian friends who support this ministry with your prayers and faithful financial support. Thank you and may our loving heavenly Father richly and bountifully reward each of you a hundred fold is my prayer!

Everything that God has accomplished in this ministry in these 55 years has been to your credit! Our workers and I am here in the shop everyday five and some of us six days a week, but we could never have produced anything without a building to house the ministry, the equipment and the wherewithal to purchase the paper and printing materials! It's you folks that have made all of this possible by paying the bills so that we can hire good experienced help, keep the equipment running and the lights on. We want you to know that we do not take your generosity and sacrifices for granted. Thank you!

Over these many years, we have had hundreds of churches who committed to support only to drop by the wayside in a few months. So I want to extend a special "thank you" to all of you who have stayed by the stuff for 10, 20, 30 and some of you for 40 and 50 years. Your faithfulness has been an inspiration to Shannon and me as you had been to Dad. Thank you, thank you, and thank you!

Because of your faithfulness, millions of people the world over have received a copy of God's precious written Word who otherwise may not have!

This ministry is a cooperative effort of like faith Baptist Churches working together to accomplish a great work for the Lord, producing and distributing His written Word, something that no one church could ever do by themselves! Unfortunately, with these huge price increases – through no fault of our own – after cutting back to two trailer loads of paper a month it is highly unlikely that we will be able to come close to last year's production unless the Lord works another miracle and soon! So, for now, we are doing what we can with what we have just waiting on the Lord!

We can, however, take comfort in knowing that our God has not left us. He is alive and well, has everything under control, and still wants and intends for His Word to be produced and distributed. The only thing that we are asking all of our Scripture partners and friends to do is to Pray, Pray, and Pray! As E.M. Bounds, an old-time preacher, author, educator and prayer warrior has said, (not an exact quote), "Prayer will motivate God to do things He might not otherwise do." So, please pray, and let's see what the Lord will do! We urgently need to get back to purchasing three trailer loads of paper a month ASAP!

The price of three trailer loads of paper has increased from \$105,000 a month to \$135,000 and with the price increases on all of the other materials that we purchase (plates, inks, glues, cover stocks) and shipping, we need to increase our level of support and paper sponsors by \$40,000 a month. To be able to purchase a 4th trailer load of paper a month, we would need to increase the amount of support \$85,000 a month, \$1,020,000 a year! I know that with God, all things are possible and He has promised to supply all of our needs according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. While my feeble mind cannot begin to comprehend or imagine how the Lord could possibly provide that kind of money, we know that He is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we can ask or think!

Last year we received \$1,863,030.54 designated for Scriptures, but because of these price increases we spent \$2,411,759.03 to produce 2.4 million Bibles and Scriptures. When we do the math, that comes to just a fraction of a cent over \$1.00 per copy; but when you consider that 425,640 of them were whole Bibles, 1,195,070 New Testaments and 780,084 Bible portions, that is a whole lot of Scriptures for the money. The cost of a Bible, New Testament or Bible portion will vary from language to language, depending on the size, number of pages, and the type of cover. A Bible that cost \$2.50 to produce now costs \$3.25 to produce, a New Testament that was \$0.65 is now \$0.85 to produce and a \$0.15 Bible portion now costs \$0.20 to produce, but they are still distributed free of charge!

By reducing our paper purchases by one-third, from three to two trailer loads a month, we can expect our production to decrease by one-third also, from 2.4 million to 1.5 million, from 28 containers shipped to 18 or 19, maybe! If reducing our production were not bad enough, the decrease in production is going to affect our efficiency drastically; our two-man web press crew will only have sufficient material to run two maybe two and a half weeks, sweeping the floor or doing bindery work the other 7 or 8 work days. This will result in spending more time to produce fewer Scriptures! The good news is some folks must have been praying, for in February the Lord provided the funds to retire the balance of what we owed on the installation of our second, larger web press and retired all but \$100,000 of our paper debt, praise God and to Him be all the

glory! There have been a few times in the history of this ministry when the Lord provided the funds we would need before we needed them, but as with every church that I have ever been a part of, the funds usually only come after much prayer and fasting and often at the very last moment!

Given the funds to purchase four trailer loads of paper a month, we could produce 3.5 to 4 million Bibles and Scriptures a year; we have the personnel, the equipment, the capacity and capability to do it! With six trailer loads of paper a month, plus two additional fulltime workers and an upgrade to our bindery system, we would have the potential to produce 5 million Bibles and Scriptures a year. With enough paper and a minimal financial investment, we could double what we produced last year! With that kind of production, some additional warehouse space would be nice, but we can manage without it!

Folks, I am not complaining, Lord forbid. I am so grateful and thankful for what the Lord has provided, but why is it in the Lord's work that missionaries and ministries like this one should have to manage with less than what we need? If it is the Lord's will then so be it, but it sure would be wonderful and far more productive if we were not always having to manage with less than enough!

Most Christians would say — and I understand — that the Bible teaches us to wait upon the Lord! But just maybe it's the Lord doing the waiting...waiting on us to pray and ask Him to provide or waiting on us to turn loose of some of the money that He has already blessed us with! One thing is for sure, we are never going to ever evangelize the world and fulfill the great commission with "God bless you's" and pocket change!

This reminds me of a story I heard some years ago about a pastor trying to exhort his congregation to be more faithful with their tithes and offerings. The pastor exuberantly and enthusiastically proclaimed that with limited money their church would only be able to walk. "If you want our church to get up and run you are going to have to give more generously!" To his disappointment, instead of getting any "Amen's," one of the men in the back of the auditorium shouted, "Let her walk!" I believe the Lord's work requires haste, and if so, then we need to get up and run! Only one life will soon be past; only what is done for Christ will last!



Standing in a government school classroom listening to the teacher open class with a reading from the Bible, then praying before telling the class to turn to their lesson in the front of their Bibles. For some of us, it is a program, a familiar scene from our past. For some, it's not something that's ever been possible. We don't see this in America, the freest nation on earth, but by God's grace and the gift of God's Word going out around the world through Bible & Literature Missionary Foundation, this scene is becoming common in the Philippines, Peru, Mexico, Honduras, Africa, El Salvador, and many more countries. As countries like El Salvador, Argentina, and Peru fight back against the drugs, the moral perversion, high crime and violence, corruption, gangs, and suicide, they are seeking a solution and finding it in the Scriptures!

In the Philippines, hundreds of thousands of bilingual Tagalog-English New Testaments are distributed in evangelistic and discipleship campaigns in schools, on campuses, institutions, government bases, police, jail, universities, and many more open doors. Churches across the islands are laboring to turn their nation back to God, and

they understand the generations to come must be readied now! Bible & Literature Missionary Foundation has provided not only a bilingual edition New Testament, but an English specially-marked edition with 20 discipleship lessons included in each Bible. These lessons are used by teachers and students, staff and faculty, as well as police officers, military, even those in rehab programs and jails, and discipleship programs in local churches. Many refer to this as "values" classes, teaching morals, ethics, integrity, honesty, purity, and a spiritual relationship with God that promotes a national respect. What was once common here is becoming common there as doors open to evangelism and Christ-centered education with their textbook, the Bible.

While we can, we need to get the Word to the fields in need and pray for this freedom to grow until the whole world knows. Everyday in cities and countries around the world, the Word of God is influencing and impacting classrooms and communities as tens of thousands receive a copy of God's Word and the materials to help them grow in grace and in knowledge.



Even though the Lord Jesus Christ was the Word incarnate, He chose and emphasized the importance of the written Word of God. The phrase "It is written" is used some 80 times throughout the Bible, and the Lord used the phrase some 26 times in the Gospels. Jesus viewed the Word of God as the final authority and repeatedly used the phrase "It is written" in His preaching, teaching, and during His own temptation and trial. In Matt. 4 and Luke 4, the Lord repeatedly used the Scriptures to thwart the assault of Satan. If He used the Word of God as the sharp two-edged sword that it is, then should we not recognize the need for you and I to use the same Word in the spiritual battles that come in our lives and ministries?

The Lord's temptation in the wilderness gives us both the pattern and power that is needed to be victorious. Jesus said in John 8:44 that Satan is a liar and from the beginning we see that the Devil's tactics are to cause men to doubt the Word of God.

In the Lord's temptation and victory He gave us the pattern and power to be victorious as well. The Lord answered every temptation with the authority of the written Word of God. As a matter of fact, He emphatically countered each temptation with "IT IS WRITTEN." Recognizing the authority of God's Word, He appealed to what was written in the Scriptures. This is the same method and practice that we must take if we are to be victorious.

A word study on the phrase "It is written" shows us that the first recorded words of Jesus (though He had the fulness of the Spirit and was God incarnate) upon the beginning of His earthly ministry are an assertion of the authority of Scripture, recognizing the authority of God's Word. If we go a little farther in the word study, we then find that the phrase "it is written" is in the perfect tense and could be rendered "it stands written." In the New Testament, the meaning of the word written, found in the phrase

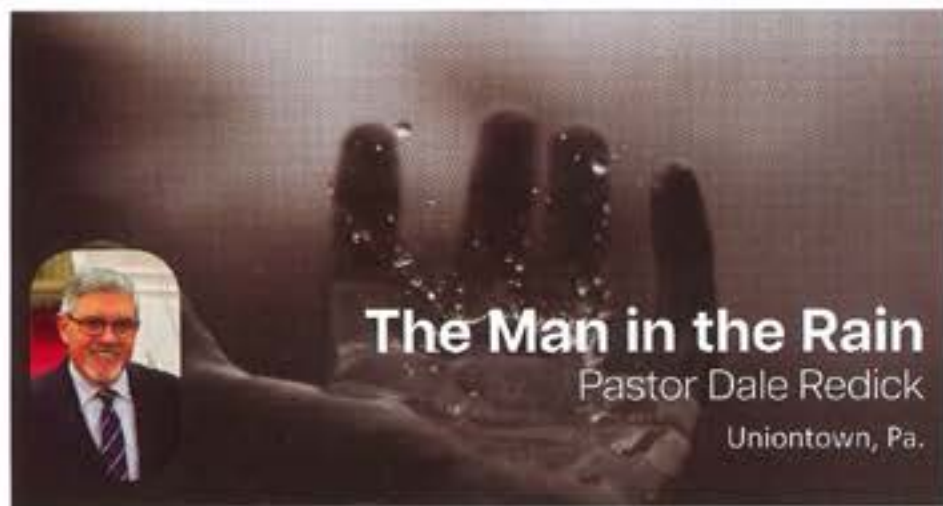
"It is written", is in the perfect tense. The perfect tense means the action happened in the past with results that keep coming to the present. Simply put, it stood written long before it was written. It was known by God from eternity past and it only found its way onto parchment when the writers of the Bible transcribed what they heard from the Holy Spirit. The Word of God is eternal.

The Lord Jesus handled the Old Testament as the truth ("Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth." John 17:17). If you do not believe one part, how can you believe any part? If you do not believe what Jesus said about the Bible, then can you believe what Jesus said about Himself. For He declares Himself to be the revealed Word of God and the fulfillment of Old Testament prophecies written about Himself as the only means of salvation for all mankind.

Christianity is not a religion, nor can it be compared to religions. Although religions contain some truths, they are not the truth. Every aspect of our faith in Christ and in God's Word is truth... absolute, unchangeable truth. In a world that is fallen to the power of Satan and sin, we must take up the responsibility to print, publish, and distribute the Word of God. If we are going to be victorious in our lives and ministries, if we are going to bring salvation to a lost and dying world, then we must embrace the same standing on the written Word of God that the Lord Jesus Christ embraced during His ministry.

Matt. 24:35 "Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away."

1 Peter 1:23 "Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever."



On a rainy day in the fall of 1976, a young man walked across the campus of a community college heading to class. He noticed a man holding an umbrella and next to him a box from which he was handing something out to everyone who passed by. He made his way over to him to find out what was important enough for him to be standing in the rain. When he came to him, the man handed him a King James Gideon New Testament.

Little did he know that moment would change the course of his life and the life of tens of thousands of others also.

He began to read the New Testament on and off over the next two and a half years. During that time, he had been invited to a Baptist church in the area.

Great conviction took hold upon him, and on a stormy Sunday night, he walked into that Baptist church and asked the Pastor if he would show him how he could be saved.

That young man was my brother, and he is the reason I am saved. Within six months we were both actively soul winning and influencing teenagers in the church to join us. Eventually we both were called to preach and attended and graduated from Hyles-Anderson college. While there, we helped start a ministry at a Big Ten College. Over a three-year period, we saw over six hundred souls come to Christ. We believed that someone had to care and try to reach them. Many of those converts went back home sharing the Gospel in many states in America and to other nations around the world. After graduation we both started churches.

Since that time forty-four years ago, we have remained faithful to

Jesus and His command of sharing the Gospel. In my personal ministry in Indiana and now in Pennsylvania the Lord has allowed us to see tens of thousands of souls come to Jesus in our church ministries. That does not include those won to Christ through missionaries we have supported. It also does not include the Bibles we've sponsored through BLMF.

Unfortunately, there are a lot of churches that talk about winning the lost, but put very little effort into it.

I grew up with Independent Baptist Churches on either side of where I lived, but they never made it to my door. Thank God that He did not forsake me. He gave Himself a witness through His Word.

All of this from one man alone in the rain simply handing to anyone who would take one, the most important Book in the world, the King James Bible. We will never know until we get to heaven how many souls have been reached because of that one day.

The ripple effect won't be known until the end of the ages when all tallies are recorded. There have been men that have approached me and have told me that because of one act of kindness that I or my brother had shown kept them in college they are pastoring today. So many acts that seem so incidental may impact someone for Christ.

I take no pride in those things that God has done through my life. I realize it is only because of the grace of Jesus. It never would have happened had not the Word of God been placed into the hands of a lost man. God did the rest.

For the next ten years, I carried

a New Testament in my pocket everywhere I went. I read it and I used it to share the Gospel. It was and is precious to me.

We must get the Word of God to a lost and dying world; it is the only answer. Missionaries need the tools: Bibles, New Testaments, John and Romans, and tracts.

Without the Word how can a man know his condition? How will he be convicted of his sins? How will he fear a Holy God and seek His forgiveness without the Word of God?

We should ask ourselves, what can we do to help BLMF produce and get the Word of God to the World?



The entrance of thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple. (Psalms 119:130). As a 20-year-old young man, shortly after coming out of Communism behind the Iron Curtain, I received a gift Bible from a friend in 1992, while attending College in Hungary. Six years later (as an exchange student) the reading of this Bible led me to Hopewell Baptist Church (Napa, CA) where I got saved and was called to preach. Because of that background, I consider myself a debtor to those who don't possess a copy of the life-changing Word of God!

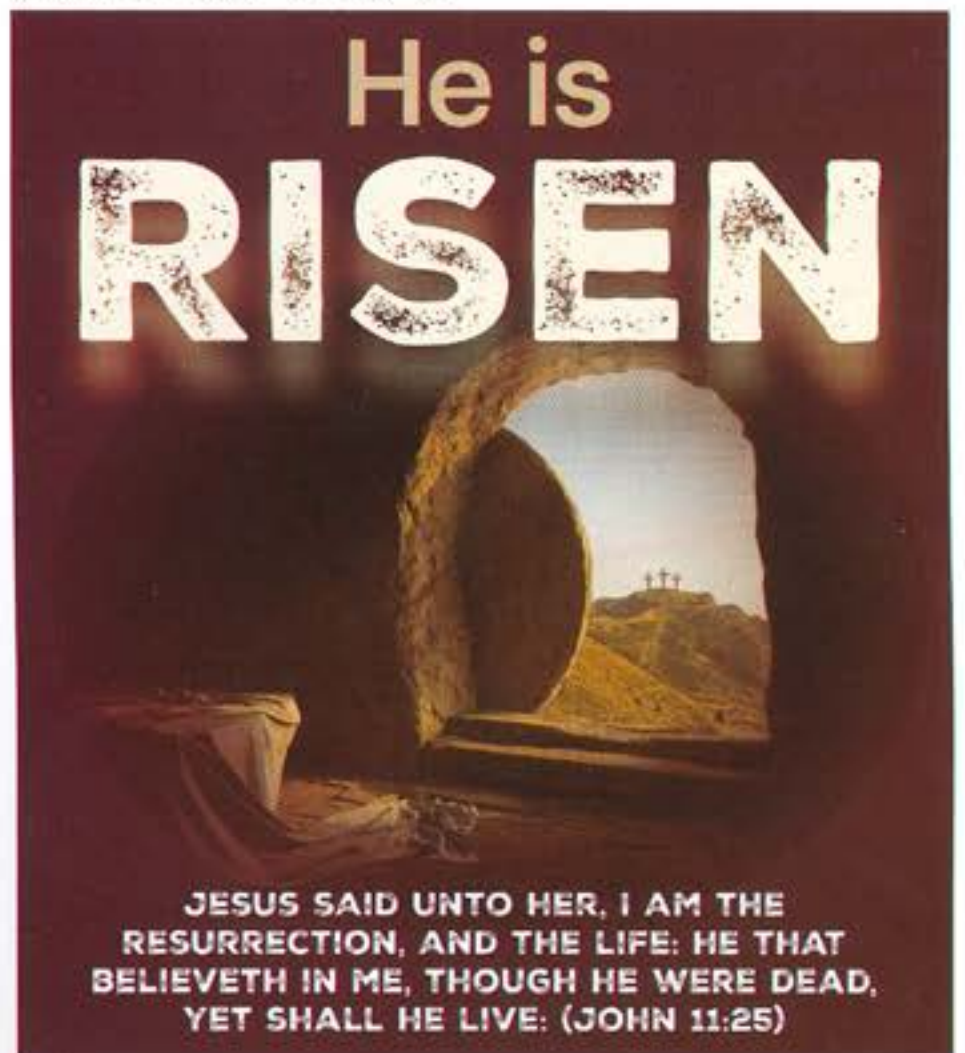
In the recent years, the Bible Barn from Shelbyville supplied hundreds of thousands of Scriptures to Eastern European countries, including our mission field. Besides Hungarian Bibles, we received Scripture in many languages, thus enabling us to supply the foreign population of the prisoners including the Algerian Muslim man who just got an Arabic BLMF Bible a couple weeks ago from my own hands. Since our primary focus is to be a soulwinning prison ministry in Eastern Europe, it is essential for us to be supplied with a large number of Scriptures in as many languages as possible. Hungary has a rapidly growing foreign population and serves as a main migration route between Asia and Western Europe; these facts greatly reflect on the incarcerated.

Our latest joint effort is to deliver Bibles to war-torn Ukraine. When the war broke out, we immediately launched an effort to help the

suffering people, especially suffering Christians! First, we worked at border crossings as exhausted refugees entered Hungary, and soon we started a refugee ministry with a pastor friend and his local church at a Refugee Camp. About a dozen refugees had already gotten saved when the government decided to shut down the camp, but as the Lord closed one door, He opened a new one in Ukraine!

We realized the great need for Bibles and got word that BLMF would print large numbers of Ukrainian Scriptures. Soon we were in discussion with Brother Lemmon at BLMF to be included in this project, and we even volunteered for a week with our family in the Barn to encourage the work!

The BLMF container arrived at our warehouse by the end of 2022, and soon we started to supply dozens of Ukrainian churches. The Scriptures opened several doors and allowed us to witness God's hand in action! Soon we connected with churches where people have a desire for the prison ministry, and we started to send Ukrainian Bibles to the prisoners of Ukraine. Also, one church just invited us to their baptismal service where newly saved war refugees decided to follow the Lord in baptism. Currently, we are taking monthly trips to preach, teach, and assist as the Lord allows! Our cooperation with BLMF is fruitful and blessed. We recommend this ministry to be supported in every way!



Why Should The Local Church Support BLMF

Romans 10:17 says, "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." We know the Bible is important. According to Barna research, the average Christian home in America has 4.4 Bibles. I know I have four Bibles in my office as I write this, and yet much of the world does not have one and could not get one without people like BLMF. We are blessed and spoiled here in America to have so much access to the Word of God.

So why should the local church support BLMF to send Bibles around the world? Reason number one: I can't do it. I don't have the time, money, or know how. We support missionaries because we can't go to all of the countries around the world. We don't know the languages, so we send others who do. Supporting BLMF does what the local church can't do by itself, but together we can support them to do a great work.

Most producers of "Bibles" are concerned about the financial bottom line. Not concerned about the purity of the text, not concerned which version they produce, just put something out for sale. BLMF only produces Bibles that hold to the proper text. There are organizations getting corrupt versions of "Bibles" out to people like our military. The Jehovah Witnesses will give by the millions to get out their New World Translation. So why can't more local churches partner with BLMF to do better in getting out the King James Bible?

Until about 6 years ago, I had never heard about BLMF. I met Bro. Shannon Lemmon and his sweet family at a Bible Conference in Maryland. After talking to him, I wanted to get him in our church for Missions Conference. Knowing that they produce Scriptures free of charge to foreign missionaries,

I wanted our church to be a part of getting Bibles around the world. We took them on as a missionary so we could help get God's Word around the world.

After visiting the Bible Barn and seeing what a tremendous work they are doing with volunteers and minimal staff, I wanted to do more, but didn't know how. Then about a year ago, Bro. Lemmon put out a challenge for 3,000 churches or individuals to purchase one roll of paper a year. I did some quick math and came to about \$20 a week. I asked our small congregation if we could have 20 people give one dollar a week so we could buy one roll of paper to send out 500 Bibles. They took the challenge, and to my surprise did so much more.

God has blessed our country. We are only stewards of that money. Is the local church being good stewards of God's money? Are we doing everything we can to get out the Word of God? Can my small (in size) church do more since the time is short?

I believe it is possible for almost every local church to ask their people to give \$20.00 a week to get 500 Bibles in the hands of missionaries to give to a lost world. Bible-believing Christians are willing to give to a great cause if they know the need. Why can't we get 3,000 rolls of paper to BLMF to keep the presses running eight hours a day, five days a week?

The time is short. Christ is coming soon. The local New Testament Church needs to rise up and get involved in the production of God's Word. BLMF is a great place to start. Will you say to BLMF as Paul said in first Corinthians 9:23, "And this I do for the gospel's sake, that I might be partakers thereof with you."

Production Report

I cannot believe it is already March, so we are going to move on and not revisit last year except to ask, if you support this ministry regularly and did not receive a copy of the beautiful magazine "From the Field" in January, we sincerely apologize for the oversight! To make amends, if you will let us know, we would love to send you a copy as it gives a complete report of last year's production, where and to whom they were shipped including an acknowledgement of appreciation from those receiving them.

After the price of paper "went through the roof", we continued purchasing three trailer loads of paper every month until July of 2023 when we cut back to two a month. Consequently, things have slowed down somewhat until we can increase our level of financial support and paper sponsors to compensate for the price increases. However, that being the case we have still had a respectable production for January and February of this year; printing 150,000 Bible portions and 105,000 whole Bibles with a run of 100,000 Ukrainian New Testaments on the press now!

We shipped a container the first week of January to Central America, but since it had been scheduled to ship before Christmas, it was counted as part of our 2023 distribution. We shipped a second container, the first

for this year in February; English/Tagalog New Testaments going to the Riley's in the Philippines with two more containers, one of Spanish Bibles and New Testaments for El Salvador and a second for Alaska with English Bibles and New Testaments ready to ship. In addition, we have shipped several pallets and multiple cases so far this year, totaling 67,065 Bibles and Scriptures in January and 95,492 Bibles and Scriptures in February.

We started 2024 with requests for 30 containers, less these three shipped or ready to ship, leaving us 27 more to go, an impossible challenge if we are to be limited to two trailer loads of paper a month. We know from experience that there will be more requests coming! Hopefully, we will be able to supply at least 18 or 19 of these requests this year!

On behalf of Pastor Loyd Warren, all the pastors on the BLMF board of directors, Shannon, and myself, thank you for your prayers and faithful financial support! Most of all we want to thank the Lord for the recent special offerings that have allowed us to retire the outstanding debt that we owed on the installation of the larger web press and a large portion of our paper debt! To Him be all the praise and the glory! May God bless you all!
