July 24 Prayer Letter

Dear Praying Friends,

Thank you for praying for us this last month. The Lord has blessed us exceedingly. He has given us safety as we have travelled, opened doors for us in churches, used us to challenge and help God's people and has allowed us to see souls saved.

After Faith's graduation from Translator's School in San Luis Potosi, Mexico, we went home to Cuautla, for about 10 days. It was a blessing to see how the Lord is prospering the new work in Yautepec under the direction of Brother Anibal Jimenez. On Wednesday, June 12th, while out soulwinning in Yautepec, I met Gabriela Rivera. I spoke with her for a while and then asked her if she knew if she were to die if she would go to Heaven. She said that her mother went to an "evangelical" church and that she had gone with her, but that she didn't know that she was saved. I started witnessing to her. She was standing about 10 feet from the front door of her house (There was a door on the outer wall and the house is inside a distance from the wall.) and people from inside starting calling her to come inside. She refused. They insisted, but she still refused. She wanted to hear the Gospel. It was a blessing to see her pray to accept Christ.

We returned to South Texas on Saturday, June 15th. As we have been travelling people and churches have been so kind to us. We are indebted to our Father and to His people for the many kindnesses. Pastor Timothy Aguiar and the Iglesia Bautista La Puerta Abierta of Weslaco, TX were a great help to us as we prepared to start travelling as a family.

We had a meeting at the Bible Baptist Church of Odem, TX on Sunday night, June 16th. There was a lady in the service, Amanda Soliz, that had been coming to church for about a month, but had not yet accepted Christ. After I preached, she came to the altar and told Pastor Sandoval that she wanted to be saved. Praise the Lord! She got saved that night!

On Sunday June 30th we presented our ministry at the Calvary Baptist Church in Evening Shade, AR. During the invitation two people raised their hands indicating their need to be saved. Sherry Jackson got saved that day. Then on Tuesday July 2nd, Pastor Deaton here took me to visit the other man, Martin Gomez, and I was able to share the Gospel with him in Spanish and he got saved. Praise the Lord! Both Sherry and Martin obeyed the Lord and were baptized Sunday, July 7th. We are thankful that that church also took us on for support.

Lord willing, at the end of August we will be going up to Alaska to visit churches. We should return to the lower 48 at the beginning of October. We need to visit a few more churches and then prepare to return to Mexico. Furlough is coming to a close. Thank you for praying for us. We are thankful to be able to team with you through your prayer support and giving to help get the Gospel to the world. We feel unworthy of all the kindnesses that we have received as we have travelled. We have been greatly encouraged by the outpouring of love.
