Teaching All Nations has been contacted by missionaries and national pastors in the following locations. We have included the cost for travel, TAN Conference, training, and expenses to start a Bible College in their church. When funding is provided, we will move forward with exact dates. These are the countries we would like to go to in the next six months:

Cuba-\$10,000

Kuwait-\$22,000 (We will also train pastors in Saudi Arabia and Iraq and host a ladies meeting)

India- \$16,000 (this would also cover ladies meetings at five locations and multiple churches and two TAN conferences)

Mexico- \$7,500

Guyana- \$6,000
