BEAMS Bible Day, Sunday, February 2, 2025


Every year, BEAMS asks churches to prayerfully consider receiving a special offering for Bibles. BEAMS has designated Sunday, February 2, 2025, as BEAMS Bible Day (some churches choose another Sunday). This year's project is Bibles for Missionary Doug Sisson. Bro. Sisson has served many years in the General Santos City in the southern part of Mindanao. Our goal is to raise \$80,000 to provide 5,000 Cebuano and 5,000 English Bibles.



Bro. Sisson will distribute these Bibles to the churches in remote areas in Mindanao.





Sister Gaddes shared these testimonies of how BEAMS is helping their ministry, with one of our donors. "I have the privilege of teaching scripture class in the public schools to kindergarten to year 6. I was able to take some of the BEAMS slimline Bibles into the schools. My older students were so excited to hold a real Bible. Many wanted to take them home; they were very disappointed when I could not give them one.

I have one student that was new to scripture class and he said he didn't believe in God. He ended up loving Scripture class. When I gave him a Bible to read during the year and was showing him how to use it, he looked up at me with a huge smile and said, 'this is my first time to actually read out of the Bible.'

A lady that I have been reading the Bible with each week over the phone owns a very large Old Testament and a separate New Testament in a different version. I was having to text her the New Testament so we could read together. We were able to meet face to face and I gave her a BEAMS Bible. She was so thankful. She had no idea that you could get a whole Bible. I received a text the next day about how happy she is to have a Bible."
