He was so happy and so was I. Glory! We gave out many more Gospel tracts to others and left many on doors that no one answered. Praise the Lord for the written Word of God.

Once again, we were privileged to take BEAMS Bibles to Pastor Alex Castillo in Apodaca for His missions conference. It is a small church with less than 100 in attendance, but they support 67 missionaries monthly at 500 pesos (\$25 USD) each! We were humbled and greatly encouraged to up our own monthly missions giving. So, we increased our monthly missions giving through our home church, AND began supporting the Faith Promise Missions program at our Mexican church as well. You cannot out-give God.

We took a flight up to New York City to be with our sons Joe, Will, and Danny and their precious families. They are doing a great work for the Lord, and we are so proud of them. Pastor Danny allowed me to preach to the church people. What a joy! All of our grandkids are growing up, and it made me cry when we had to leave. Being a missionary will do that to you. But we trust the Lord to care for them and to lead them. In January, Danny's wife Abbie Jo will be having another baby, our 12th grand baby! We would like to be there and help out, but we are praying for them as we are here in Mexico.

Mrs. Gloria Huff, and all the good people who support Wonderful Word Publishers had asked us to take over the leadership of this amazing ministry that prints and distributes tracts for Mexico. We spent several hours with Mrs. Gloria in business meetings during November and went to the bank to be put on the business account. We went to the Dallas Courthouse, and then on to the Austin, Texas Secretary of State. We have now turned in all the paperwork for us to officially become President and Vice-President of Wonderful Word Publishers. Praise the Lord for a ministry that was started back in the 1960's and can continue on for the furtherance of the printed Gospel in Spanish. We take this responsibility very seriously and are thankful for all who pray for and support Wonderful Word Publishers. This is a tax-exempt corporation registered in the state of Texas and will continue to be so as we print the tracts. We were able to print 10,000 tracts for a church in southern Mexico and ship them to their church during November. Amen!

Last night we distributed thousands of Gospel tracts printed through Wonderful Word along with BEAMS Bibles at a pastor's conference in El Cercado, Nuevo Leon, Mexico. What a joy to supply much-needed materials. The Pastors were very grateful.

Thank you all for your prayers and support. Please pray for us as the ministry of printing and distributing is growing that we will have wisdom and the workers for the ministry.
