Thank you for your prayers and offerings during this entire year, 2024. You are a great blessing to our family and ministry in the Octava Region of southern Chile. We ask in our prayers that the Lord continue blessing your lives and each one of your ministries during this upcoming 2025. Hebrews 6:10.

Let me share with you what the Lord has allowed us to do during November. I was invited to preach at the Missions Conference of the church led by Pastor Emanuel. It was a great blessing— souls were saved, people surrendered their lives to serve the Lord in the full-time ministry, and we also went out soul-winning, and had a great result with several souls saved. The conference had a good attendance and was a great blessing to our lives.

At our church in Monte Águila, we went soul-winning and door knocking, and our van began leaking all of the water within and the engine burned out. We have had to leave our van at someone's place while we look for a used motor for that van, which we use for our bus route in Monte Águila. A used motor costs approximately \$1,700, including the installation of it into the car. We hope in the Lord that we will soon gather the funds so that we can continue running our bus route. Praise God for the brethren who, in some way or another, pick up the new converts and those who live farther away from the church so that they may continue coming to church, despite the unavailability of the bus route.

Praise God for the work in Yumbel. We continue onward, doing visitation in the hospital, soul-winning in the public squares, and we are also visiting a group of young people struggling with addiction. Brethren, please continue praying for the town of Yumbel. God is good.

I beg of your prayers for my mother and sisters who had an accident. My mother broke her knee, and my sister broke her shin. Both have advanced diabetes so their wounds struggle to heal properly; however, my sister, who usually takes care of my mother, is in more critical condition than my mother right now. I had to travel to Mexico to spend a few days with them and be a support for both of them. Frankly, we are worried, as just a few months ago one of my other sisters passed away due to the same illness. I ask that you please pray for them, and that I may able to help them during this time of difficulty.

Thank you, dear brethren. We trust in the Lord that, in this year, 2025, we may be used by Him and that all glory to be Him.
