It has been a little while since our last prayer letter and much has happened. There have been many victories as well as some setbacks.

Soccer ministry - We started a soccer ministry this month to get men out to hear the Gospel. Our men are very excited. Each week one of our men have taken turns to preach a short Gospel message before we play. We have had a number of lost men come out.

Evangelism - We go out on Saturday mornings to preach in the park in the middle of town and pass out tracts. When we began, there weren't any other churches in the park. Women's meetings - We have begun to have meetings with our ladies twice a month to compliment what we are doing with our men. We have seen positive results with our ladies embracing God's purpose and plan for their lives.

Jean and Priscila - They are currently separated. They had a serious blow-up at the end of December and she filed a restraining order against him. Please pray for reconciliation.
