It has been an excellent start to 2025, and we are thrilled about our plans for this year. God has kept us busier than ever, and we're so grateful for the many opportunities to help those who have reached out to us—more than ever. Serving these individuals is an incredible blessing, and we're so thankful for your prayers and support, which make it all possible.

Our relationship with **Immanuel Baptist Church** in Jacksonville, Florida, has already proven to be precisely what we needed. It has been a tremendous blessing to us. We aim to be there every five or six weeks, and earlier this month, we had the privilege of spending time with the Chomas. We plan to be there again in February and March. Attending services at Immanuel is always a joy. The church has embraced our ministry wholeheartedly, and we genuinely feel their love and support. That encouragement means the world to us.

Pastor Neal recently spent a week with us here, and we made exciting plans for the future. One key focus right now is establishing a budget that will allow us to accomplish everything we need to do this year. Our monthly budget is approximately \$5,000, and we ask you to pray that God will provide through churches and individuals who see the value of this ministry.

We're also excited to announce that our first **Restoration Workshop** of the year will be held in April. It's going to be a fantastic time together! While we'll still meet on Thursday and Friday like in the past, the workshop will end at 4 p.m. on Friday instead of Saturday morning, allowing everyone a head start on their journey home. We will also provide materials for all attendees. Stay tuned for more details in the coming weeks!

Another exciting event is on the horizon for 2026—something we've dreamed of since moving here: a **Restoration Camp Meeting** under the tent at the Red Barn! Plans are already in motion, and we're working on a great program. We are excited about the potential of this meeting to encourage and inspire those in attendance. On a personal note, I'm thrilled to announce the upcoming release of my new book within the next 60 days. This 36-day devotional focuses on David's prayer of repentance in Psalm 51 and has proven to be a powerful tool in helping people restore their relationship with the Lord. We'll be sharing details about its release soon. Additionally, two more books are in the works and should be released later this year.

We also had an unusual experience here at the Red Barn this month—for only the second time in the seven and a half years we've been here, we saw snow! This time, however, it stuck! We got about five or six inches, and it stayed on the ground for several days. While it was a beautiful sight, the weather brought some challenges. Please pray for Brenda, as she slipped while walking out to feed the animals and landed hard on her tailbone, fracturing the bone. She's in extreme pain and moving very slowly. We're praying for a quick and complete healing so she can return to all the work needed. Please keep both of us in your prayers for good health—we need strength to accomplish everything God has called us to do.

Please join us in prayer as we continue to work on improving the facilities at the Red Barn. One of our current needs is installing a water softening system, which will help preserve our equipment and improve the quality of our well water. This project will cost about \$1,500; we trust God to provide it. We plan to expand our housing facilities by adding a couple more tiny houses this year to accommodate more people.
