Dear Praying Friends,

We started out February still in Thailand. The first Saturday of the month the members of Bible Baptist Church in Chonburi begin passing out the tracts we purchased for them to have. We were able to help them get 20,000 tracts which is the goal for the church to distribute this year. The Pastor reported that they passed out 360 tracts that day and were blessed to see 32 people make decisions for Christ.

The first week Amber and I were in Bangkok at our Distribution Center, and we were able to receive the Thai whole Bible project. We helped unload the 8,000 whole Bibles that were printed. We began making deliveries to various churches and Pastors in the area. We had a chance that week to go out soul winning with Pastor Pran and the folks of Grace Baptist in Pathumthani. I was able to talk with six young college students. We were blessed to see a young man, James, trust the Lord.

Since arriving back in the States, we have been dealing with health issues as many different bugs seem to be going around. So far, we have not missed any meetings. Please pray for health concerns.

As I mentioned in our last letter, Tan and Pim have stepped out by faith to come join BEST Missions full-time. He will and has been visiting churches in Thailand to talk about how BEST can help them. Tan is coming to the States at the end of March. He will only be here for two and a half weeks. We already have his schedule full as far as church services. If you would like to grab a meal with us, we will be in Alabama, Florida, and then onto Texas for the time he is here. I would love for you to meet Tan if schedule allows. He is going to be at our first Gulf Coast Regional BEST Conference at Bible Baptist Church in Spanish Fort, AL, on March 28-30. I hope you can plan to be there.

Some already have taken Tan on for financial support and we thank you! Some individuals have expressed interest and asked for information. He needs to raise \$1,000 a month to be fully supported. January 2025

2024 was a great year for BEST Missions! In January I always like to review the previous year and rejoice in what The Lord has done. We were able to publish 13,504 whole Bibles, 1,376 New Testaments, 687,133 John and Romans, and 10,000 Gospel tracts. 2024 was also the 20th year of ministry for BEST. In those 20 years, we have been able to publish 183,083 whole Bibles, 132,477 New Testaments, 6,274,906 John and Romans, and 30,488,960 Gospel Tracts. Like the Psalmist said in Psalm 118:23, "This is the Lord's doing; it is marvellous in our eyes."

I don't think there is any way to adequately estimate the number of souls that have been saved or lives that have been changed through God's Word going out since the beginning of the ministry here in Thailand and now at least 16 different nations that BEST has been privileged to send God's Word into. The churches in Thailand have shared with me the results of their efforts in December through Christmas Gospel programs, there were at least 100 young people who made public professions of faith and thousands who heard a clear presentation of the Gospel and received a Thai John and Romans along with a Gospel tract to take home.

Amber and I have enjoyed being in Thailand for January and visiting some of the churches, preaching, giving a report about BEST, and getting reports from them about the results of the Word of God going out. Many have expressed their appreciation for the Bibles that have been given to them and how the Word of God has spoken to them.

One of the things we did was to sit down with Tan and Pim and discuss future goals about BEST. Tan has expressed a desire to step out by faith in the past to do more with BEST Missions. We agree and are at the point where the timing is right for him to take this step. There are more churches requesting Scripture than I can physically visit not just in Thailand but in all Southeast Asia. Tan and Pim have stepped out by faith to come on board full-time with BEST Missions. He has already carried the title of Distribution Manger but now that carries greater responsibility. He will now be working as a Missionary Evangelist helping churches throughout Thailand and Southeast Asia as the Lord provides the means and opportunities. Please pray for them as he will be working to raise some support from churches here in Thailand and in the States as the Lord directs.
