That should pretty much finish off all the offerings we have received!!! By the end of March, all our printing machines and all our Bibles and tracts and John/Romans will be snuggled safely inside the new shop! I still need to install lights and electric, but I am so happy I could bust!

Carrie and I were soul winning on our bus route and I saw a guy standing beside his black Honda 750 Shadow Spirit motorcycle cruiser. I approached him and oohed and ahhhhd about his bike. I told him I used to have the same bike, but mine was white. We talked a while, and the conversation turned to the Lord Jesus. He sweetly and wonderfully prayed to receive Jesus as his Savior. Carrie doesn't like motorcycles but we had a great time talking anyway.

There is a new pastor and a new church on the northwest end of Monterrey that needs some help. Mario, their pastor was the assistant pastor at our church here in Escobedo for many years. He had the biggest bus route, and he had many families in church because of his efforts and his love. But the Lord called him to start a new church in the area called Garcia. They started about a year and a half ago. They meet in a densely populated colonia (Neighborhood). They rent a tiny apartment there. Regularly they have over 80 in attendance, and on big days, they have more than 100. They have a lot of good men that the pastor has disciplined. We recently gave out Bibles there and we took the class of children (about 15) out to the park for the morning kids church. The Problem? They have run out of space. They need to buy a bigger place. They have found an abandoned orphanage that a Baptist group used to operate. They want to buy it. They have a little money, and they have regular and faithful tithers in the church. We would like to help them purchase this property.
