The theme for our church's 2024 Mission Conference was *Neighbors Next Door*. The focal point of the conference was found in Luke 10:29 when the lawyer asked Jesus, "And who is my neighbour?" I must admit that when I first saw the conference theme, my initial thought was, "I have witnessed to my neighbors." However, it is amazing how much things have changed in my lifetime. There are many people within Greater Cincinnati who have come to this area from other countries. According to an article published January 24, 2023 by soapboxmedia.com, "Over a four-year period (2014-2017), metro Cincinnati experienced the largest percentage

metro region in the country...In metro Cincinnati, international communities have been growing – migrants from West Africa, Mali, and Burkina Faso, in Westwood; Guatemalans in East Price Hill and Covington; Bhutanese and Congolese in Mt. Airy and Boone County; Ethiopian and Somali in Florence; Burundi in North Fairmount." Other large groups of immigrants have recently come from Ukraine and Venezuela. Now it is not as difficult to "Go ye into all the world," because the world is all around us—they are our neighbors.

BPS Workers - Pressmen, Bindery Operators, Graphic Designers, Pre-press Operators, Cutter Operators, Folders, Material Handlers, Shipping & Receiving Clerks, Laminator Operators, Secretaries, Representatives, General Labor-Our people wear many hats. We have many more jobs than we have people available, yet the work Think on these things continues to be accomplished because of the dedicated workers. Volunteers - Praise the Lord for our dedicated volunteers! We have folks who faithfully give of their time to come in daily to assemble John & Romans or to load pockets on the bindery. Volunteers regularly help us cut, stitch, fold, emboss, engrave, bind, and many other tasks as needed.

Equipment - While we often see the numbers of Scriptures produced, we typically fail to consider all the equipment needed to produce those Scriptures: the 4-web Heidelberg press, the 6-web Goss press, the Miller sheet-fed press, the Didde press, the digital presses, the bindery line, the single-pocket binder, the hardback binder, the laminator, the engraver, the folders, the cutters, the stitcher, the plate maker, the forklifts, the shipping scales, and many other pieces of necessary equipment.

Computers - We have computers throughout the facility to keep everything operating smoothly and efficiently, and to help with ongoing communications.

Paper - This is our most valuable resource; we cannot print without it! We currently go through a truckload of paper each week. That doesn't include all the sheet paper we use daily.


Ink - It goes without saying that to produce Bibles we must have ink. With our current printing process, we order 55-gallon drums of ink and pump it to the presses.

Facilities - Continual upkeep on the building is necessary to print God's Word. In order for the paper to run through the presses efficiently, the printing areas must be humidity controlled. The heating and cooling units must be maintained and kept operating smoothly. Air handling is essential on our equipment, so air compressors are required for the equipment to work properly. Charging stations for material handling equipment must be in good working order, and safety throughout the shop must always be a conscious effort.

Support - Ongoing monthly support and offerings given for paper are vital to the ministry. God continues to provide through His people, and His Word continues to be produced in greater levels than ever before. By the end of this year, we should reach 250,000,000 copies of Scripture printed at *Bearing Precious Seed* since 1973. Praise the Lord for all that He has done and continues to do! God uses the financial, prayer, and volunteer support of churches all across the country to keep the ministry going. Thank you for your involvement in getting the Word of God all around the world. Let's continue to join together to do more for Him.


