During January and February, we had a lot of hot weather, with days on end of temperatures in the 90-degree range and some days up to 101°F. This heat slowed me down because it was strong! Pastor Larry Owens here has been suffering because of the heat also, and it had slowed him down to the point that he was not able to go to church for a few services. I was concerned for him and decided to pray and send a letter out to raise funds for an air conditioning unit for his bedroom. I led the people here to give for the air conditioner, and many other pastors responded. We were able to get an air conditioner for his bedroom and for the kitchen dining room. Praise the Lord! Thank you for your prayers and for responding towards this need.



On the 24<sup>th</sup> of February, I received the news of the passing of my mother, who was in a nursing home in Texas. On the 5<sup>th</sup> of March, I traveled back to the USA for the funeral. On that Friday, all of my siblings gathered for a special evening together before the funeral. It was a wonderful time filled with cherished memories. The funeral took place on Saturday, March 8, in Greenville, Missouri, where many uncles and relatives came to support us.
