Following a month long intense spiritual battle with devils (literally) and members in the church during March, our trip to the States was timely. We were able to visit our son BJ at Bible college and drop off our daughter Sissy with her Grandmother in preparation for college entrance in August. As we returned back to the DR we hit the ground running: a Mother's Day conference at the end of May, mentorship work in preparation for camp, evangelist groups to host, and preparing for camp has us in over drive. Please pray for our summer camp which begins on June 9. The Theme is , My Son, Give me thine heart. As we lead the young people to work in order to earn their way to camp, would you please seek the Lord with us for the financial provisions. We will provide work in the garden, in construction work, community cleaning and more. But we need the Lord to touch the hearts of willing and able brothers and sisters in Christ to sponsor the work that the young people do. Each camper needs \$150 to cover their expenses. Please prayerfully consider this project.

Presently the Haitians on both sides of the island are in distress. On the DR side immigration is very hot- guarding hospitals in order to get Haitians going into them, searching hospital rooms, breaking into homes in the middle of the night and check points everywhere leaves our people full of anxiety. In Haiti, a collapsed society and a country gone mad leaves the Haitian people without a place to go. Please pray for them.
