

April Prayer Letter 2025

Dear Praying Friends,

Thank you for praying for us.

On March 10 th , Pastor Mike Ray and his wife Verna arrived in Mexico City. I picked them up at the airport and took off for Orizaba, Veracruz. Tuesday, Pastor Ray taught several classes to the men while his wife taught the ladies. Then we were off to Cuautla, Morelos. Wednesday evening Pastor Ray preached in the midweek service in Yautepec. four people accepted Christ that night. Thursday and Friday we had a meeting for pastors from the area. Pastor Ray did some general teaching and then we divided up for sessions for men and women during the day. Wednesday afternoon we tried to have a Bible Club using his Gospel Cartoon, "Jose Got The Answer Right."

But instead of children coming we had a group of 8 adults that came. Six of them accepted Christ. Praise the Lord! While he was here, we saw 11 people saved. His teaching and preaching were challenging and inspiring. The Rays flew home on Saturday. Their visit was a great blessing to us and our people.

On Friday March 14 th , my Uncle Clark passed away. He was 84 and lived in Childress, Texas. After my parents divorced, my brother Mike and I lived with him and Aunt Patty for about 4 years while we were growing up. I am indebted to Uncle Clark and Aunt Patty and felt that I needed to go for the funeral. Mike and I were living with them when my mother passed away when I was 7. I flew into Dallas on Friday, March 21st. They had the viewing that night and then I preached his funeral on Saturday morning. It was good to see some relatives that I hadn't seen in years and to meet some relatives for the first time. I was supposed to be preaching at a Mission's Conference in

Leon, Guanajuato that weekend. I had to explain to the pastor that I needed to go to the funeral. After I got back home, a pastor from Juitepec, called me on Friday morning, March 28 th asking if I could preach in his Mission's Conference that night. (A missionary that was supposed to preach had some car trouble.) I ended up preaching there Friday and Saturday night.

Last Tuesday we had a Bible Club in a neighborhood called "La Gemma" in Yautepec. Several people from the church in Cuautla came to help us. 35 people came for the Bible Club. We sang songs, played some games, had a memory verse and then watched the cartoon, "Jose Got The Answer Right." Twelve people were saved in the club. Praise the Lord!

On Thursday April 10 th , we drove Faith up to San Luis Potosi. She is back in the mountains of San Luis Potosi helping a missionary there with a Bible translation. She was supposed to be there for a month, but the missionary there decided that he wants her there for two months. She has been visiting churches here in Mexico to raise some support and it appears that she will be going to the US to try to raise support before returning to the Philippines this fall. Please pray that she can raise the support she needs.

This Sunday, April 27 th , we will be celebrating "Child's Day." We will be having a pinata, candy, sandwiches and other things to encourage people to come. Please pray that the Lord will work in lives this weekend.

Lord willing, next week we will be having a Bible Club in a housing development called "San Carlos." Please pray with us that people will respond and souls will be saved.

Thank you for participating in our ministry through your prayers and offerings. We are deeply indebted to you for all you have done to help us serve the Lord here in Mexico. It is a privilege to be able to serve the Lord here.
