In March, we started working with a new church called Bwerenga Bible Baptist Church. The pastor had only been there a short time and needed some help. They only had a few adults coming on Sunday mornings, and the spirit was a bit down. He was really thrilled when my family started going out soul winning with him. In 2 months, we saw 39 saved and 5-6 visitors each week. We also had 5 that the pastor baptized in the lake.

Now that sounds nice to baptize in the lake, but it really was not that special. It was a two-mile walk there, and many could not make it . . . and he also had to poke around to make sure there were no crocodiles. They had a baptistery tank, but it had big rust holes in the bottom. So, I have been getting that fixed up and painted so that we don't have to take the four-mile round-trip hike to the lake anymore! We already have several lined up to use it once I get it back in place.

I have also been building a steeple for the church. Now I just have to paint it. Angela was witnessing to a lady only about 30 feet from the front gate, and the lady did not even know a church was there. So, the steeple will show everyone clearly that a church is indeed there. We also built a big sign to go out on the tarmac road to point to the church.

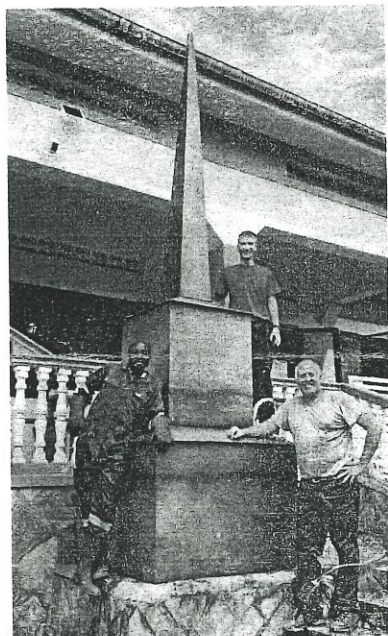

They did eventually find the church, and I had the joy of leading them both to Christ after the service. We should get the new sign in the ground next week to help others find their way.
