We are extremely excited about a new church plant in a small town of 30,000 people in the state of Zacatecas! A pastor in the U.S. has someone in his church with a burden for this town. He came for a survey trip last April. The Lord has called a young man to start the church. As far as I know, this town has never had a good New Testament Baptist church. The Lord has provided a wonderful place for the church and a wonderful team of workers! He has given six workers who will be there for the entire eight weeks and another six workers who will be there for a month each or for a few weeks. He has also given us two wonderful places to stay for the eight weeks, one for Viry and me with the young ladies, where we will also have all of our meals, and another for the young men. The people of Tlaltenango, Zacatecas, have been open to the Gospel. We will be arriving on Tuesday, June 10, and leaving on Monday, August 4. Our work is primarily soul winning, visits, and discipleship seven hours a day, six days a week. The first church service will be Sunday, June 15.

The Lord is also putting together a wonderful team for an eight-week evangelistic campaign in an indigenous community in the state of Guerrero and for another eight-week campaign in the capital city of Chiapas. Both new church plants will be yet this year.

We need your prayers for the Lord to prepare hearts and for people to be saved and come to these new churches. We also need your prayers for our work of discipleship. We need to help the new converts to become faithful in the Word of God and prayer daily and in their church attendance, so when we are not there, they will continue to grow in grace.
