Greetings Dear Pastor:

The month of June has flown by us as we finally had a month without a wedding. Last wedding is July 18<sup>th</sup> in Texas. Then we head back to Nebraska and fly out July 31<sup>st</sup>.

This month we both had medical appointments. My wife had a doctor appointment in April, but they wanted to do an echocardiogram to make sure she is doing well. The results were good. It showed that the pumping of her heart increased from 40% to 45%. That is a 5% increase which is excellent news!!!

I went to my doctor appointment and the results of my lab work were very good. My liver count was normal for the first time in several years. My ferritin levels were very good. I do have to return in July for two things. They are changing my medication and so I need to have it checked after several weeks of being on it. I also need to have a biopsy done on two bumps to make sure they aren't cancerous. It is not expected to be, but still need checking. Please pray that these things go well.

The work in Thailand is going well with an attendance of 35 last Sunday morning. Sutin is in place and doing an excellent job!
