We made a deliberate effort to engage our teenagers more actively as helpers, and it was a joy to see them step up with such a willing and Christlike spirit. We were encouraged to see some new adults step in to help—what a refreshing boost to the team! Typically, our core workers are quite worn out by week's end, but this time, the extra hands truly lightened the load and lifted spirits.

Teen Class:

After HBC, we have seen growth in the lives of our teenagers, with one of them placing her faith in Christ a few weeks ago after church. We had our first offsite teen activity, which included minigolf and ice cream. It was a great success! The following day was our "Family Emphasis Sunday." Every age group in our children's ministry took part in the service through song, including our teens, who shared two special pieces. For many, it was their first time singing in front of a congregation, yet they stepped forward with willing hearts and sang beautifully.
