

Prayer Letter December 2025

Dear Praying Friends,

Thank you for praying for us these last few months.

It seems like 2025 has flown by. We have so much that we are thankful for. The Lord has been so good to us this year.

We made it back to Mexico on Tuesday, November 4<sup>th</sup>. We are thankful for what the Lord did while we were in the US, but there's no place like home. I was able to preach in churches in Louisiana, Alabama and California. While we were travelling most of the time just our daughter Faith presented her ministry. But we were able to present our ministry in a few churches and one new church in Louisiana took us on for support. Praise the Lord! Several churches took Faith on for support. Thank you for your prayers about that. I had the privilege of preaching at the Missions Conference of the Central Baptist Church in Santa Ana, CA. What a sweet group of people.

The church in Yautepec is doing well. There are three new families that have started coming in the last few months. We have seen several people saved while out soulwinning and have had visitors in the services. While out soulwinning I met 96-year-old Santos Morales. He has a place where he sets up kitchen ware that he sells every week in the downtown area of Yautepec. I started talking to him and realized that his hearing was good and his mind is still clear. I presented the Gospel to him and he accepted Christ. Praise the Lord! Last week I met Jose Guardarama. He is a 72-year-old homeless man. He was open to listening to the Gospel and also accepted Christ. Thank you for praying for us and Yautepec. There are so many people that need to be saved.

It seems like we just got home and now we are preparing to leave again. Next Monday, December 15<sup>th</sup>, we will leave for the U.S. Lord willing we will be crossing the border on Tuesday December 16<sup>th</sup>. We need you to pray for us during this trip. The farmers have been closing down the highways these last several weeks and we could be stuck on the highway for 6 or 8 hours at different places if we get caught in one of their highway closings. (Normally the drive to the border is about 14 ½ hours.) To get to the border we have to drive through the state of Tamaulipas. It is an area where there is a lot of violence and from time to time, they stop vehicles and steal them. We always avoid driving in Tamaulipas after dark.

We should be stopping in Houston at my sister's house. I have signed up for Medicare and we are trying to see if Eneyde can get it also.

We will be spending Christmas at our daughter Meriam's house in Blue Springs, MO and then Faith and I have a flight leaving Kansas City for Seattle on January 2<sup>nd</sup>. We will be there until the 4<sup>th</sup> when we will be taking a late-night flight to Taiwan and then for the Philippines. I will be there with Faith for 9 days helping her get settled in and then fly back to Seattle on January 15<sup>th</sup>. It appears that I will have a few opportunities to preach while I am there. Please pray for the Lord's blessing on His Word. I am so thankful that our daughter is following the Lord's will, but it is going to be hard

leaving her on the other side of the planet. It is almost time to leave for the Philippines but there are still a lot of things that we need to figure out. Please pray with us about this.

Sometimes, Eneyde is doing well, sometimes she is in a lot of pain because of the back surgery she had in 2021. Sometimes I am fine and then sometimes the brain fog wins and I'm down. On Sunday, November 30<sup>th</sup>, neither of us were able to go to church because of our conditions. I am thankful that I have a good man, Brother Esteban Rodriguez, that is helping us in the church in Yautepec. I have been told that Nicotine patches can help relieve the symptoms of long Covid. When we get to the US, I want to buy some and see if it helps.

We are looking forward to 2026. At the end of January, we will be preaching and teaching at a family conference at the Iglesia Bautista Monte Horeb in Mexico State and then in March I will be preaching a revival at a church in Tlaxcala.

Thank you for praying for us and being a blessing to us this year. We are thankful that the Lord is saving souls and changing lives here. I trust that you will have a Sweet Christmas with your loved ones.
