The young man has been saved and baptized, and has been attending faithfully. He is able to speak Thai, but his Thai is limited when using larger vocabulary. As a result, we now have Chinese individuals seated on one side of the translation table, while people from Burma are on the other side. To help bridge the language gap, my wife casts translations onto several screens, one of which now displays the Burmese language.

Future Plans for Burmese Ministry

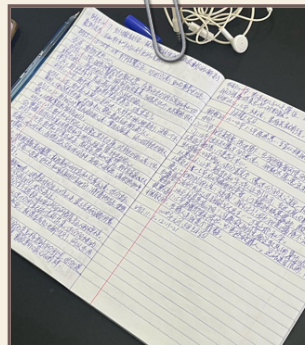

At that house I was able to lead a man to Christ whom had heard the Gospel before and was so excited. Then my wife led this neighbor to the Lord and my partner led an elderly lady at the back of the house. God led us to the right place!



This man is 96 years old and James led him to Christ. One Saturday Sutin asked me what is down this road, I said we have never been down it, so we went down it and at the end of the road was a dead end with two houses. That is where we found this man. When we were finished we were rejoicing realizing that no one had ever come to that house before to present the Gospel.
