

Dear Friends and Pastors,

Although we did not get the freezing sleet and snow that many of you got in January, still it got quite cold here in Monterrey. Houses here do not have heat, so we just bundle up. (And we turn on the kitchen oven!)

We loaded up two of our broken-down RISO printing machines during the cold, and took them to Beaumont Texas, where our good friends and brothers in Christ re-furbished them like new! Special thanks to James and to Paul!!! You guys are real life-savers! They dropped everything and rushed our repairs! We stopped in at Community Baptist Church of San Marcos, Texas along the way. These good folks have been supporting Wonderful Word printing ministry for many years. What a great encouragement they were to us that day.

A 60-year-old man named **Beto** came to church with us a few weeks ago from our bus route. **He accepted Jesus as his Savior.** We visited him for several weeks after and finally met his wife, **Olga.** She has a very large tumor that is very noticeable. The doctors have already operated on her, and say that they can do no more. **She listened to the Gospel of Jesus Christ very reverently and tearfully accepted Jesus as her Savior.** She became very happy afterwards, knowing her future is secure in Jesus! Thank GOD for Heaven!

The good folks at **BEAMS** in Gulfport, Mississippi purchased 1,080 Bibles for us here in Mexico on January 15, and purchased another 1,070 more on January 24! These Bibles will go to pastors who are teaching and discipling their new converts in the coming months! Last year, 2025, **BEAMS purchased 9,431 Bibles for us to distribute here!!!** Praise God for the Bible! The greatest need that missionaries have is BIBLES! We do not hand Bibles out like Gospel tracts. Rather, they go to Pastors that know who will read it and use it. We want to be good stewards of the Word of God.

There is a very large group of Christian recovering drug addicts near our house. Instead of selling drugs, now they send their converts out into the neighborhoods selling burritos to support their ministry. This past month we have been supplying this group with thousands and thousands (**87 cases**) of the booklet, "**Juan y Romanos**". It is a marked edition with the Gospel road-mapped throughout. These recovering addicts now give these out freely to everyone and they preach Jesus and testify with their changed lives!!! What a joy to provide the Word of God to these people. We also give these out at the hospital, on the bus route and at red lights to the street vendors.

We had visitors from Texas for Christmas! Carrie's mom and step-dad brought our niece Kassie with them for a week. We took them to see some churches, enjoyed their sweet fellowship, and let them help with the work of preparing Bibles and tracts for distribution. We are set-up to receive visitors here in Monterrey. Come on down and go soul winning with us. Preach with a translator! See what God is doing here personally. Maybe God would use a Missions trip to do a great work in your heart.
