Dear Praying Friends,

"I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth." (III John 1:4) We are rejoicing as a family because our son Benjamin, at just six years old, has trusted Christ as his Saviour! What makes this moment even more special is that he came to faith at the same age his father did. We are so thankful to see Benjamin's tender heart respond to the Gospel, and we ask you to pray with us that he will continue to grow in his love for the Lord and in his desire to serve Him.

This fall will be a very special season for our family, as our daughter Lydia will be graduating from Hyles-Anderson College. Just a few months later, on June 26, she will marry TJ Mahaffey. Lydia will be our first child to graduate from college and the first to be married, and our hearts are full of gratitude to the Lord for His goodness in guiding her steps. We are so thankful for the way God has prepared Lydia and TJ for this new chapter, and we ask you to join us in praying for them as they begin their life together, seeking to honor Christ in their home and future ministry.

Nancy has visited our church twice, and on her second visit, she brought her father-in-law. Soon after, I went to visit them in their home. As we talked, I shared the Gospel, and Nancy opened her heart to Christ—she was gloriously saved! While we spoke, I noticed her father-in-law's eyes filled with tears. When I asked if he wanted to trust Christ, he told me he had already been saved at 16 years old. He shared how he had been praying for his family's salvation for many years, though his own mother had died without Christ. That day, he rejoiced to see God answering his prayers through Nancy's salvation.

We are excited to share that our church has begun a special five-week program, and the Lord is already blessing in wonderful ways. Our very first Sunday was "Goldfish Sunday," and the Lord brought in 231 people! It was such a joy to see the church filled with families and children, and we are praying earnestly that through these weeks, many souls will be saved and follow the Lord in baptism. The supervisor of the public schools in the municipality of Zaragoza has officially given us permission to enter all of the schools to preach the Gospel! This is yet another door the Lord has opened as we continue working to take the Gospel to all of the 16 municipalities of Chimaltenango.

From March 10–13, we will be visiting 16 schools and presenting the Gospel to several thousand children and teenagers. Please pray that hearts will be tender and receptive and that Christ will be exalted in every place we go.
