Executive Summary

By God's grace, our church in Libreville is actively evangelizing, baptizing, discipling, and expanding Gospel outreach into new cities throughout Gabon. We are deeply aware that the fruit reported in this letter is not ours alone—it is fruit that abounds to your account (Philippians 4:17). Thank you for laboring with us.

Soul Winning

The year 2025 was a year of remarkable Gospel advancement. By the grace of God, **more than 500 souls trusted Christ as their personal Saviour in 2025**. This is not the result of human strategy, but of faithful sowing and the power of the Word of God.

Our soul-winning efforts have extended throughout:

- Libreville.
- Surrounding communities.
- Nearby towns and villages.
- Public marketplaces.
- Neighborhoods.
- Door-to-door visitation.
- Bus stations and high-traffic areas.

Several **thousands of John and Romans booklets and Gospel tracts** were distributed to individuals from all walks of life—students, market workers, taxi drivers, families, and government employees.

Mobility has been one of our greatest challenges. Transportation limitations have restricted our ability to reach farther villages and to bring converts consistently to church services, yet even with these challenges, the Gospel has continued to advance. We are praying earnestly for increased mobility so that we can reach even farther regions of Gabon with the message of salvation. “. . . *The harvest truly is plenteous . . .*” (Matthew 9:37) The harvest is ripe here.

Baptism

The Lord continues to add to the church. Among those recently baptized were **Edith and Rosa**, who not only publicly identified with Christ through baptism, but soon entered our discipleship program. After faithful instruction and growth, they are now actively serving in the church ministry. It is a tremendous joy to see new converts move from salvation to baptism to service.

Several additional baptisms are already scheduled for 2026, and we are praying that many more who were saved in 2025 will follow the Lord in believer's baptism. “*Then they that gladly received his word were baptized . . .*” (Acts 2:41) The Gospel is not stopping at conversion—it is producing commitment.

Ministry Expansion

The Lord is opening new doors across Gabon:

- **Kango** – A ministry extension has officially begun in the city of **Kango**, where Gospel preaching and Bible teaching are taking root.
- **Ntoum** – In the city of **Ntoum**, two faithful brothers, **Mathurin and Etienne**, are currently overseeing and strengthening the ministry work there. We are praying that this effort will develop into a strong local church.
- **Libreville** – In Libreville, we currently have **six ongoing home-based Bible studies**, reaching families and neighborhoods that might not yet attend regular services.

The ministry footprint is expanding, but so are the needs.

Prayer Requests

1. **Purchase of a dedicated soul-winning bus**, which would dramatically increase our ability to:
 - Reach distant communities.
 - Transport visitors to church.
 - Expand evangelistic campaigns.
2. **Purchase of land for a permanent church property**, which would provide:
 - Stability.
 - Visibility.
 - Long-term ministry growth.
 - A permanent Gospel lighthouse in Libreville.
