Soul Report:

During the first two months of this year, we were grateful for the opportunity to share the Gospel with **twenty** people, **eight** of whom trusted Christ as their Saviour. Spring has begun to show itself in Preston, which has increased our likelihood of having more Gospel conversations. On one such nice day, I had the opportunity to witness to two “lads”—one who considered himself an agnostic and another with an Eastern Orthodox background. Praise the Lord, by the end of our conversation, both had bowed their heads and trusted Christ!

We have also seen two of our teenagers trust Christ, and many others are beginning to open up and ask questions about the Scriptures. Your prayers are being answered! Another special moment was having the opportunity to witness to a Kurdish man named Zemer. I have since been able to follow up with him and give him a New Testament in his language, Soranî.

Church and Discipleship Update:

January’s highlight was our “Fellowship Sunday,” where Layton Kelly, missionary to the addicted, preached and shared an update. One of our men, Lee, graduated from Bro. Kelly’s program in Dublin in January, which greatly encouraged our church. It is a blessing to see missions giving bear fruit so personally. The attendance on that Sunday broke 100 again, which gave us another reason to praise the Lord!

In February, we held our Roundup (VBS-style) on a Friday evening, followed by Roundup Sunday, which included several special moments shared with our church family. What a joy it is to serve Jesus! God impressed on my heart the need to devote more time to discipleship, so this year I began teaching a virtual class on Thursday evenings. **Two brothers** have already completed Level One, and **three more individuals** have finished Level Two.
