Dear Praying Friends,

February found me beginning the month still in Thailand. I was able to be in Northern Thailand at two new to me churches. We have supplied Scriptures to both churches for many years. It is a blessing to me to finally be able to get into new churches. Since Tan has come on board with us full time, it has allowed us to go to new churches as he is able to translate for me. One of those churches held a conference at the end of February and Tan was able to go back there and help them with translating the preaching. During the conference Tan had the keynote speaker present the Bible college students their own copy of the Thai Pastors Bible. They were thrilled to receive such a special gift.

I was hoping to still be in Thailand when our 48<sup>th</sup> container of Scripture arrived but it was delayed until the third week of the month. It was a blessing to know that it arrived, was unloaded, and distribution of it has already begun. BEST was able to get 374 whole Bibles, 40 New Testaments, 45,000 John and Romans as well as 800 Gospel tracts distributed this month.

We are making plans to load our 49<sup>th</sup> container of Scripture on March 12<sup>th</sup> at Colonial Baptist Church in Rogers, AR, at 9am. If you are in the Northwest Arkansas area and would like to help, we would greatly appreciate it. Please pray as we notice an increase in shipping costs with the schedule of this container. Normally a container costs us between \$6,000 and \$6,500 but this one was quoted to us at \$7,300. We have 3 more containers scheduled to be loaded and shipped this year. Please pray with us as we need the Lord to provide the funds for this.

Once back in the states, I was able to rest a little bit before getting back on the road for meetings. I was able to be in six churches and two missions' conferences.

Join us in prayer about the need for a van. We have begun hosting more people on missions trips to Thailand. I would love to talk with your church about one! To make those trips easier for travel and to also help us deliver Scriptures when not hosting people, we are praying for a van. We still have our truck and plan to keep it. When rainy season comes, a van would make Scripture deliveries easier. Currently the cost of a good, reliable, used van runs between \$30,000 and \$32,000. Would you pray for the Lord to provide one? Would you consider helping with it? Would you consider coming to visit Thailand? It is exciting to see how the Lord is working in the churches in Thailand!
