Update on My Wife's Oral Surgery

This month, my wife underwent oral surgery, which was a great success as they managed to save her tooth. She had seven stitches, which have already been removed. It will take six months for the bone graft to fully heal, and she still cannot eat on that side of her mouth. We are grateful for your prayers. She was nervous about the procedure, but it went very smoothly.

Fuel Crisis

The conflict in Iran has negatively impacted Thailand's fuel situation. Thailand heavily relies on fuel from the Strait of Hormuz, and we've faced limitations on how much we can purchase. At times, gas stations run out of fuel. Currently, we are paying 41.39 baht per liter, equivalent to about \$4.79 per gallon. Please pray for relief to come soon.

We are planning a significant Sunday celebration on April 5th to honor the Resurrection of our Savior. While we regularly invite people to church, we are making extra efforts to spread the word about this special day. The adults have been challenged to bring two visitors each.
