Greetings:

We are working with the printer to see if he can get our ProgressResorts printed and mailed more quickly this quarter. In the meantime, Nolin and I are doing very well. She has been suffering from some tooth infection that came AFTER her dental surgeries were completed. She is in a lot of pain and yet goes out to care for a bedridden elderly lady—a lifelong Catholic who asks for her specifically. Nolin is sharing Christ with her and works to see her in Heaven someday.

I'm doing great at 70. I've lost more weight, come down three notches on my belt, and my memory is improving—sometimes. I feel like I'm in my twenties. I have energy that runs circles around the teenagers. Pray for THEM. I can't wait to see what I get to do for my King in the next 70 years! More souls, more preachers, more churches.

Visionary Trips:

I've not said much about these this year because the weeks filled up so rapidly. We have a few new ministries to visit, a hospital where patients lie on the floor because they cannot afford a bed, and a home for abandoned elderly who need medical care. Some of the churches are raiding funds to make hygiene bags for these good people, and we will, of course, share the Gospel with them as well. I expect to see lives changed this summer as many teens will be visiting, probably up to 30.

Touch A Life:

We now have 10 centers in Honduras, 5 in Kenya, and multiple centers in at least 6 other countries. *Impact for Others* has increased its giving from \$1,000 to \$2,000 a month. But there are millions more mouths to feed and little hearts to bring to Jesus. Let's allow what they have done to encourage all of us to do more.

The Great Commission Fund:

We are struggling to pay the preachers now because so many have lessened or altogether dropped support for our national missionaries. Please pray that those who used to feel burdened to help

these men will have renewed motivation to help again. Let's all work as if we believe that these are the last days. To whom can we witness, for whom can we pray, to what cause can we give, so that we will not be ashamed at His coming?

Smugglers:

You would think with the war going on that Smugglers would be stopped, but we are still going strong, raising funds for Bibles, which is much higher now due to the war, and training more local Believers to help. Fuel is now over \$100 a gallon, phone calls are over \$25 a minute, and paper is three to four times as expensive as it was six months ago. But the gates of Hell cannot withstand the armies of the Living God. Thank you for supporting us as your soldiers on the battlefield.

In the past three months, the reports from our preachers indicate they have:

- Started 28,964 new house churches
- Evangelized 91,237 new areas
- Had 1,059,792 unbelievers and idol worshippers receive Christ as their Savior
- Baptized 371,608 of those new Believers.

All we do is for the Glory of **The King and His Kingdom**. Thank you for letting us be a part of our Great Commission outreach. It is your priceless gift to our teams and our family.
