Dear Praying Friends and Supporting Churches,

We thank the Lord for the open door He has given us **to preach the Gospel in many schools** here in Ghana. Most schools, both government and private schools, have a weekly "chapel" time that we seek to take advantage of. One of our staff men or Bible college students will go to a school in advance to seek permission; he speaks to the "headmaster" (the principal) of the school and sometimes must present an official request to preach on our church letterhead.

There are **hundreds who need to hear the Gospel** at each school. Our hope is that each school would allow us to preach to each classroom of 30-40 students during that weekly chapel time for four weeks. Since so many Ghanaians are indoctrinated with a false, works-based salvation, we seek to thoroughly teach one or two points from the Gospel plan each week. On the fourth week, we give everyone a salvation workbook to complete for homework. For the final two weeks, we take extra soul winners to **confirm the students' understanding of the Gospel one on one**. We distribute Bibles to teachers and headmasters and also New Testaments to students whose understanding of the Gospel we are able to confirm one on one. However, this plan is not always approved by the school. Sometimes, the headmaster only allows us one week to preach once in the various classrooms or maybe even just one chance to preach to the entire school.

So far this year, our church soul winners have shared the Gospel in 6 schools in our area. At **Abrepo Methodist**, we preached for 3 weeks to 700 students, class by class. **Wesco School**, with over 900 students, allowed us to follow our preferred plan, and God blessed with great results; at least 240 students were confirmed one on one. At **Redemption School**, our graduate, Zomie Toah, preached to 300 junior high students, while our missionary, Larae Hoff, shared the Gospel with 250 primary age students. At **Supreme Montessori**, we preached to about 700 students, but we have been invited back to preach class by class; similarly, one of our men preached to 300-400 students at **Justice International**, and soul winners have gone back and preached class by class. **St. Matthew's** gave us a chance to preach to the entire student body of about 200 students and may have us back from time to time.

As always, pray for more open doors and for more laborers.
