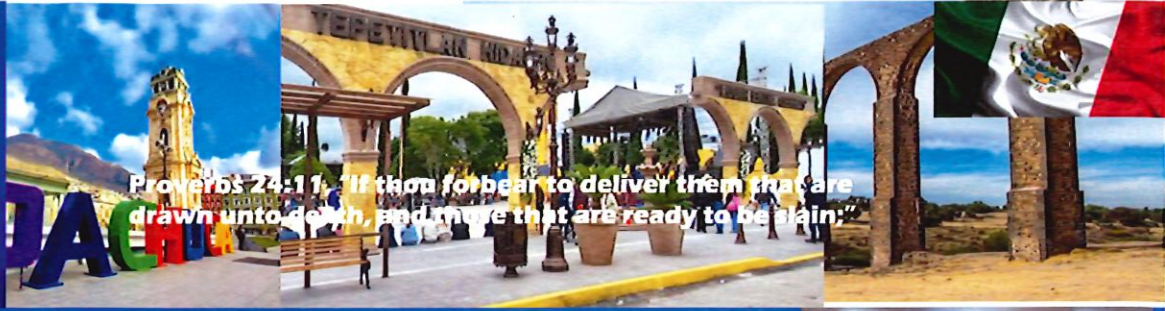

Dear church, the Ventura family, your missionaries in the state of Hidalgo, Mexico, send you greetings.

It is a joy for us to be able to share with you how good and marvelous our dear God has been toward us during these months that we have been here in the state of Hidalgo's Huasteca region.

We have visited various towns and, as you know, there is a great need for the Gospel everywhere. On one of those visits to a town in Hidalgo, we had a big accident at 3 a.m. We were hoping to arrive early to make good use of time, but the truck's motor seized up, and the motor oil spilled everywhere, causing the truck to skid. We were stuck in the middle of the road and were nearly run over by a trailer, but the Lord protected us.

We thank the churches who, with much love and effort, supported us so that we could get the truck repaired. Although it is not completely fixed, we are still using it.

We have visited several towns, and, for now, we are focused on Tepetitla Hidalgo, a town with 9,840 inhabitants, mostly women. It only has two Evangelical churches and a Catholic one. We have preached the Gospel here, and souls have been saved. God is opening doors. We pray that the Lord continue guiding us and that we may do the work He has called us to wherever He wants us.

By God's grace, I had the opportunity to preach in some missions conferences, where we have seen the hand of our good God work.

We continue onward, passionate for souls and desiring to reach all those who the Lord will allow us. We know He does not want anyone to perish.

Dear brethren, we ask that you continue praying for us, your missionaries, that we may finish repairing our truck. I also ask that you continue praying for the health of my wife Gloria, and for my daughter Noemí.
