Dear Praying Friends,

Thank you for your prayers and for your financial support. We realize that it is the hard work and sacrifice of the members of our supporting churches that keep us on the field. We appreciate you.

The year 2025 was a very productive one. We were in 4 countries, 20 states, 38 cities, 47 churches, 5 Bible colleges, 5 Soul-Winning and Sunday School Conferences, 2 Men's Conferences, 4 Family Conferences, 7 Missions Conferences, and 14 Leadership Conferences.

We handed out 3,426 tracts, and we shared the plan of salvation with 96 people, 54 of whom accepted Christ. Our annual *Fires of Evangelism* Pastors' and Workers' Conference, February 16-18, was blessed and used of God. In the final service, 37 people surrendered their lives to full-time service. On Tuesday, February 17, my dear friend, Pastor Alejandro Cordova, went Home to be with the Lord. It was my honor to preach one of the three memorial services held in his church in Celaya, Guanajuato, on Thursday, February 19. Bro. Cordova was greatly used of God. He founded and pastored the Fundamental Baptist Church of Celaya, one of Mexico's greatest churches, for over 40 years. This year was the first time he ever missed preaching in our annual February conference. He will be greatly missed, but his influence for the Gospel will never die.

So many of you have prayed for and contributed to the project of the recovery of ministry property, which was illegally taken and sold. We are making significant progress in retaking a large portion of this real estate. Please pray for a meeting Jonathan and I have scheduled on Monday, May 4, with our attorneys and the authorities in charge of the case. We are expecting and praying for a positive outcome.

My children and my wife have planned some special activities celebrating my 80th birthday, which is May 25. All of my children and most of my grandchildren plan to be here for one week. I thank God that He has allowed me the privilege of serving Him in the ministry for almost 61 of those 80 years.

Again, thank you for praying for us. You have a vital part in what God is doing through our ministry.
