Beloved Pastor and Church families,

Welcome New Year 2026! It is a joy to recognize that a new year has begun with the company of each one of you. Your support has been fundamental and of great encouragement to us.

In these two months at the beginning of the year, we look for the face of the Lord so that He would open doors for us to go and evangelize once again the most numerous indigenous people in the country, the Wayuu.

God showed us through an unexpected call from the United States from our esteemed missionary sister Eunice Bixbi Alfaro, the confirmation that there are many people in those parts and that we should not be afraid but go and preach the Holy Word of God. The call was for a Wayuu person who had won for Christ in the United States and who now, the new convert wanted that somebody speak about salvation to his mother living in Maicao, La Guajira. Well, we began to pray more fervently that God would provide for this trip, since another brother from the congregation here in Barranquilla was encouraged to go.

Brethren, in a wonderful way God provided to go soon to La Guajira and we did not doubt at any time that He wanted us there to confirm the faith of the brothers who on the first missionary trip were waiting to be visited, as well as to bring some provisions for children and women with babies.

**March – April 2026**

In March, God gave us the blessing of seeing another brother preaching God’s precious Word. Our brother Alex González, being Wayuu, is being challenged and at the same time trained to go to La Guajira as a prospective missionary among his own people. We are praying for him and so far, he has been encouraged to serve together with me in the city and at the same time he is still active in bringing the gospel to a very vulnerable place near the church here in Barranquilla.



God opened the door for us, and we went to La Guajira. We spent a week among the Wayuu people. We did not have the complete information to find the mother of the Wayuu who converted to Christ in the United States and who asked for prayer for her. By faith we went to look for it and God gave us the victory. We miraculously

found her home. She was not present, but the next day

we came to share the gospel with Dolores. She waited for us in high spirits and together with her daughter, grandson and nephew received Christ as their only and sufficient Savior. There in Maicao there were 11 souls saved and then we headed towards the north of the country, bordering the Atlantic Ocean, to Alta Guajira. The trip was not easy, after the truck got bogged down in the mud on several occasions, we walked a couple of kilometers throughout the desert. We were supposed to arrive at the meeting point at 5 pm, but we arrived at 11:30 pm. The staff who came for us did not wait any longer. We woke up on a terrace where God blessed us with the owners of that place, because they lent us «chinchorros» (hammocks) and there we rested until 9 in the morning, taking turns to take care of all the things we carried. The chairs arrived well, as did the Bibles and discipleship material. We arrived with the joy of the Lord and began to evangelize and preach in the afternoons.

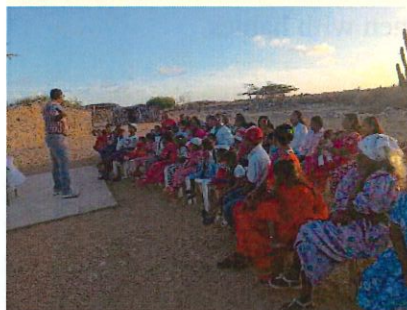


God blessed enormously by saving souls and encouraging the brethren to strengthen themselves in the faith they had believed. Some of those who were already there for a while, heard the gospel clearly for the first time and others recognized that it was what they were looking for and wanted to hear.



At the end of our journey, after many opportunities to preach on the ranches, children, young people and adults did not want us to leave. Our hearts have been anchored in La Guajira since the first time God motivated us to go and evangelize, to reach a people abandoned by the local and national government.

Thank you for your prayers, on the entire trip there were more than 30 souls saved. We ask that God will raise up a pastor and that together with us as missionaries we will prepare, train and send more workers into the field. May God send his laborers into the harvest, which is plentiful.



We asked for the provision of two vehicles for the desert. Some of these vehicles come from our neighboring country to the East, Venezuela. They give a permit, but they (cars) cannot leave the Guajira area. These are government matters, but we want to serve God and the cost of each long-cab vehicle for more

than 15 passengers is around USD \$20,000 each.

We greatly appreciate your prayers for sister Lisbeth, she is also of Wayuu descent, was with us at Church here in Barranquilla and due to family problems, she had to return to her paternal family to Venezuela. Sister Lisbeth is looking for a church in the region where she lives, but there is not even one. I asked you to pray because if there is not one nearby, then we would start one where she is in Villa del Rosario, Edo. Zulia, Venezuela. Brothers and sisters, there is a great need. We ask for your prayers that God supplies for each of them and that more missionary works can continue to be opened so that the kingdom continues to expand.
