Dear Friends and Pastors,

With great grief, we send this report. On May 13, 2026 OVER IN MANIPUR, INDIA, A Pastor and his brother and 4 other Baptists were brutally captured, tortured, murdered, and dismembered. The Pastor was TH MANU TAMANG. I performed his wedding ceremony back in 2008. Our church in Norwalk, CT has been sending him family support for the last 18 years. He preached in 7 different languages to several different congregations every week. Carrie and I are super close friends with his family. We stayed in their home in 2017 as we visited them in India. He was a better man than I will ever hope to be. But there are some local tribal groups that want to stir up a civil war in that region, and they are clandestinely performing deeds of terrorism, trying to incite the tribes to turn against each other. Whoever they are, they are especially targeting pastors who proclaim Jesus and the glorious gospel of PEACE.

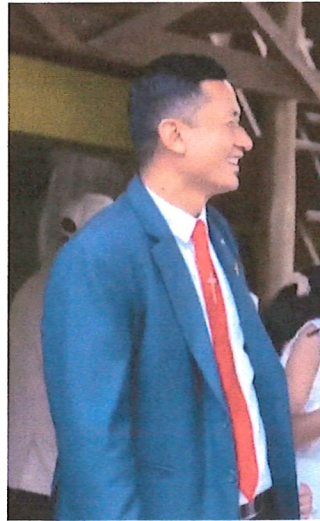
Here in Mexico, the work continues, despite the many tears shed these last several weeks over Manu. Thanks to the wonderful people at BEAMS Bibles up in Gulfport, Mississippi, we were able to obtain **2,183 BEAMS Bibles** for the Mexican Pastors to distribute to their new converts. Also, we packaged up and shipped 2,000 of these Bibles to go to a giant Pastor's conference in Celaya, Mexico that we will attend this summer.

In the **Wonderful Word** print shop, we have been printing Gospel tracts for individual churches and mailing them out across the country. One Pastor picked up 6000 Gospel tracts for his church in Cadereyta, Nuevo Leon and another 2000 tracts for a church that they started 5 years ago in La Ascencion (La Chona), Nuevo Leon. Another 6000 tracts were printed for a church in San Jose Iturbide, Guanajuato. Amen! Pastors come by to pick up Gospel tracts that we print for them and we also have tracts printed with a blank spot on the back for those who wish to stamp their information on them. Praise the Lord that we have the privilege and freedom to print here in Mexico. Glory!

In front of the public hospital, we handed out hundreds of John/Romans and gospel tracts to the family members of those who have been hospitalized. We give the family members food to eat while they anxiously await any word of hope concerning their loved ones inside. Carrie and I spoke to a young man and wife about their need of the Lord Jesus. **They both gladly received the gift of salvation that is only available in Jesus Christ.** A Mexican Bible college student used my microphone and amplifier to preach the salvation message loud and clear to the hurting and grieving people. Many accepted Jesus.

We have been using the Discipleship material produced by Mercy and Truth Publishing, Scott Hanks Pastor, Lawrence, Kansas. Every Saturday as we visit our bus route, we take the time to sit down with the new believers and attempt to ground them in basic Bible doctrines. Salvation is as easy as falling off a log. But grounding someone in the Scriptures is quite another story. With Catholic, Pentecostal, and many other backgrounds, there is a lot of false doctrine to combat, and there is a whole Bible that they need to know and believe. One new believer named Griselda sat with us in her front yard with her open Bible, pen, and booklet, while her husband busily stretched a cloth canopy over us to protect us from the sun. The husband pretended not to listen, but he heard every word. People need to plant their faith in the Bible.

Thank you all so much for your prayers as we serve the Lord here in Mexico and remotely in India. Please pray for the other 3 India Pastors, that we work with and support, for their safety, and for the safety of Mrs. Kachaek and her daughters.
