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Dear Pastor and Church Family:

Cuban Family Here in Tucumán, Argentina

I am writing to share the urgent need of a very special family who recently arrived here in Tucumán, Argentina, after fleeing from Cuba. This is the dad of Orisbel Ríos'. Orisbel came to our Bible college seven years ago and graduated. He is currently starting a new church in a local city here out in the country.



This past Saturday, I had the opportunity to meet them when they visited our church. The father was a pastor in Cuba. He shared with me that they had to leave because they no longer had food to eat, and the government had stopped providing it. Facing such desperate conditions, they made the difficult decision to flee their country in search of survival. Without official permission, they escaped and began a long and exhausting journey. They traveled by boat, on foot, and through various means until reaching Guyana. From there, they crossed all of Brazil—by bus, taxi, van, and walking—day after day, until they finally reached the Argentina border near Foz do Iguacu, where they requested political asylum. By God's grace, someone was there waiting for them and helped bring them safely to Tucumán.

This family arrived with almost nothing—only the clothes on their backs. They sold their home in Cuba to afford the journey, leaving everything behind. Today, they are starting over with no possessions and very limited resources. Right now, they are in urgent need of basic necessities:

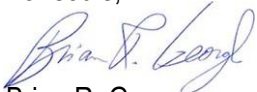
- Clothing
- Food
- Stable housing
- Daily living essentials

I am asking for prayer for this family. If you feel led, please consider supporting this family in any way you can. Your generosity—whether through financial support, clothing, food, or other resources—can make a real and immediate difference in their lives. Most importantly, I ask that you pray for them. Pray that God would provide for every need, strengthen them during this time of transition, and guide us in how we can best serve and support them. When I asked Mr. Ríos if he would ever return to Cuba, he told me there is nothing to go back to. With no food or resources left behind, they are now building a new life here in Argentina.

Thank you for your kindness, your prayers, and your willingness to help. May God bless you richly for your compassion and generosity. Their son Orisbel is building a house on a piece of land that was given to them. He sent me a letter a few days back asking for funds to finish building his house so his dad and mom can have a place to stay.

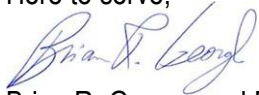
