We dedicated the month of June to focus on the World or (whirl) Events due to North America (USA, Canada and Mexico) hosting the World Cup 2026. Just outside the Estadio Azteca of the Delegation or Court House area of Tlalpan, to my knowledge 3 churches participated passing out over 9,000 tracts. Tracts were printed specially with a WC2026 logo in English and Spanish that said, "Could this be your last World Cup?". The responses were so diverse from: total refusal, to ignoring us, to accepting the tract, to actually stopping, and listening to the Gospel Story. So, we will **Keep Witnessing For Christ (KWFC)**.

The torrential rainy season is upon us and we are very thankful. Just about every day from a little after noon until way into the night, we are assured of continuous rain. The exterior cement repairs confirmed our suspicions that the hole near the ground level of our outer west wall was where the rainwater was entering, as since that repair, no water has entered.

A missionary we support, Manuel Arreola, preached for us and our people were encouraged. He is a short brother with a fiery disposition and makes a great impact wherever he goes. He has been going to Cuba for just about 10 years.

For the past several months, we have seen 81 that have been assured of Heaven, praying to receive Jesus Christ as their Lord and Saviour. Some of these people were on the streets as we preach and feed the poor, and some are from the gatherings we have strewn throughout our area during our teaching and preaching to different groups.
