Dear Praying Friends,

God has been moving in such a special way here, and I'm grateful to share some of these blessings with you. Over the past weeks, we've celebrated **18 baptisms**, rejoiced in **23 professions of faith**, and welcomed a new family who decided to join our church. Attendance has been strong, and each service has carried a sense of excitement as we watch the Lord work in people's lives right in front of us. Seeing these decisions and watching new believers take their first steps of faith has encouraged our hearts more than we can express.

We also had the blessing of partnering with a medical missions team that held clinics in **Chimaltenango** and **San Andrés Itzapa**, and the Lord truly used their efforts. Over the course of the week, they were able to help **1,637 people** with medical and optical needs. Even more encouraging, **145 individuals trusted Christ as their Saviour** during the clinics. Watching people receive physical help and then open their hearts to the Gospel was a powerful reminder of how God uses compassion to open doors for the message of salvation.

Another special blessing was celebrating our daughter Lydia's wedding on **June 26**, when she married **TJ Mahaffey**. It was a joy to gather with family, spend time together, and watch the Lord begin this new chapter in their lives. Please keep Lydia and TJ in your prayers as they settle into married life and as TJ continues with his final **three semesters of Bible college**. Their desire is to serve the Lord on the mission field, and we are excited to see how God will guide and prepare them for the ministry ahead.

We are also continuing to move forward with the fundraising needed to finish the construction on our church building. We are grateful for the generous gift of **\$3,000** from First Baptist Church toward the **\$150,000** needed. In addition, three groups have committed to come down and help us with the electrical wiring, ceiling tile, and hanging the drywall—work that will save us an estimated **\$25,000** in labor costs. Our own church family has committed to raising **\$25,000**, which leaves us with **\$97,000** still needed to complete the project. We are praying and working toward finishing as much as possible before our church's **20th anniversary on November 29**, trusting God to provide each step of the way.

As we look ahead, we're praying that God will continue to deepen the faith of these new believers, strengthen the families who are growing in the Lord, and open even more opportunities to reach our communities. Thank you for standing with us, praying for us, and investing in the work God is doing here in Guatemala. Your faithfulness makes a difference every single week, and we are grateful for you.
